NOTING THE BEARS

- Baylor posted two Big 12 wins in a season for the first time ever. The Bears won five games for the first time since the 1995 team won seven.
- Baylor finished the season with 10 rushing touchdowns, the most by a BU squad since the Bears had 16 in 2002.
- Defensively, the Bears must replace their top four tacklers from last season.
- Baylor drew a total of 194,493 fans for its five-game 2005 home schedule, an average of 38,899 fans. The average ranked as the sixth-largest in the stadium's 56-year history, with a season-high 44,783 on hand for the Nov. 5 game against then-No. 2 and eventual national champion Texas.
