NOTING THE CORNHUSKERS

- Nebraska ranks fifth in the nation in bowl game appearances with 43 and has received bowl bids in 36 of the last 37 seasons. The win over Michigan in the 2005 Alamo Bowl improved the Huskers' bowl record to 22-21.
- NU led the Big 12 in red zone defense in 2005, holding the opposition scoreless 33.3 percent of the time it penetrated the 20-yard line. NU surrendered points on 28-of-42 red zone opportunities.
- The Huskers' defense recorded an NCAA-leading 50 sacks a year ago, second in school history behind the 1999 squad's 53 sacks.
