

# Kansas Jayhawks

Bonnie Henrickson led the Jayhawks to the WNIT in 2005-06, the team's first postseason appearance since 2000. KU won its preliminary round game.

Kansas' 17 wins were its most since the 1999-00 squad posted 20 victories and played in the NCAA Tournament.

Sophomore guard Ivana Catic is the team's top returning scorer with 7.7 ppg a year ago. She also contributed 2.4 rebounds and 4.6 assists.

Junior forward Taylor McIntosh has started all but two of KU's 58 games the last two seasons. She numbered 4.5 points and 5.0 rebounds as a sophomore.

Seven freshmen join the Jayhawks' roster in 2006-07.

After losing three starters, KU will have to replace 66.7 percent of its scoring and 51.5 percent of its rebounding this season.

Kansas opened the 2005-06 season with a school-record 12-game winning streak.



Kansas State won the 2006 WNIT championship, its first postseason title in school history. A sellout crowd of 13,340 attended the championship game.


Five was the magic number for K-State last year as the program posted its fifth-consecutive 20-win season, made its fifth-straight postseason appearance and finished in the top half of the Big 12 for the fifth consecutive year.

Senior guard/forward Claire Coggins was an All-Big 12 Second Team selection last season while averaging a team-high 13.5 ppg. She was also named MVP of the WNIT.

The Wildcats return four starters in 2006-07 which accounted for 64 percent of their offense and 72.7 percent of their defense last season.

Sophomore Marlies Gipson was the only player to start all 34 games a year ago. She led the team with 62 blocks

Shalee Lehning started 28 games as a rookie and led the squad in rebounding (6.6) and assists (5.6).

# **Missouri Tigers**

Missouri finished in the top four of the Big 12 standings last season for the first time in program history. The 10 league wins tied an MU-best, set in 2000-01.

The Tigers received a bid to the NCAA Tournament and achieved their first ranking since 1984-85, entering the AP Poll at No. 24 the week of Jan. 9.

Mizzou finished the 2005-06 season with 21 wins for just the second time since 1985. The other time was in 2000-01.

MU returns three starters this season. Senior forward Carlynn Savant was named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention last year while EeTisha Riddle was named to the All-Big 12 Defensive Team.

Savant is the team's top returning scorer with 10.0 ppg last season.

Cindy Stein is two wins away from 200 for her career and the Tigers need three wins at Mizzou Arena to notch 300 home wins in program history.
