Senior guard Kiera Hardy was an All-Big 12 First Team selection in 2005 and 2006. She enters her senior season with 1,416 career points and led the Huskers with 17.5 ppg last season.

Sophomore forward Kelsey Griffin started every game her rookie season with 13.3 ppg and 6.0 rpg. She was named to the Big 12 All-Newcomer Team.

Nebraska welcomes back Jelena Spiric, the 2005 Big 12 Newcomer of the Year. She missed last season with an injury.

The Huskers made their third straight WNIT appearance last year and opened postseason play with two victories for the first time in school history.

The team's 19 wins in 2005-06 were its most since the 1998-99 season.

NU returns 70.3 percent of its scoring and 65.3 percent of its rebounding in 2006-07.

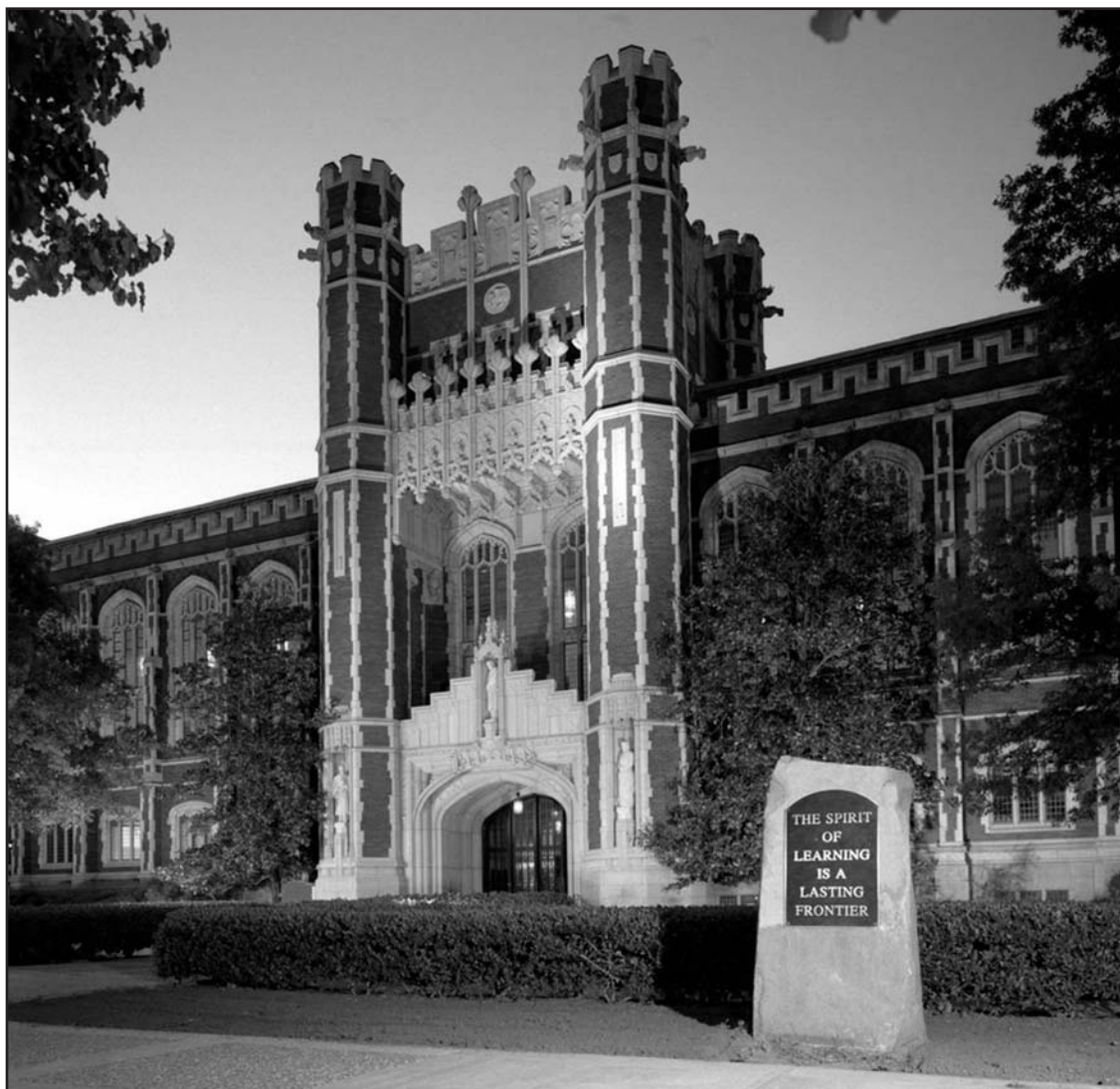

Oklahoma advanced to the program's fifth Sweet 16 in 2006. The Sooners won the 2006 Big 12 regular season and postseason championships while becoming the first women's program to go undefeated through the conference season.

Sophomore center Courtney Paris ended her rookie campaign as a consensus All-American and USBWA National Freshman of the Year. She became the only player in NCAA history to collect 700 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks in a season.

Paris also broke the 23-year old NCAA single season rebounding record with 539 boards. She averaged 21.9 points, 15 rebounds, 3.3 blocks and shot .614 from the field in 2005-06.

OU returns all five starters and four other letterwinners this season, along with a talented class of newcomers.

The Sooners have back 92.4 percent of their scoring and 83.7 percent of their rebounding from 2005-06.

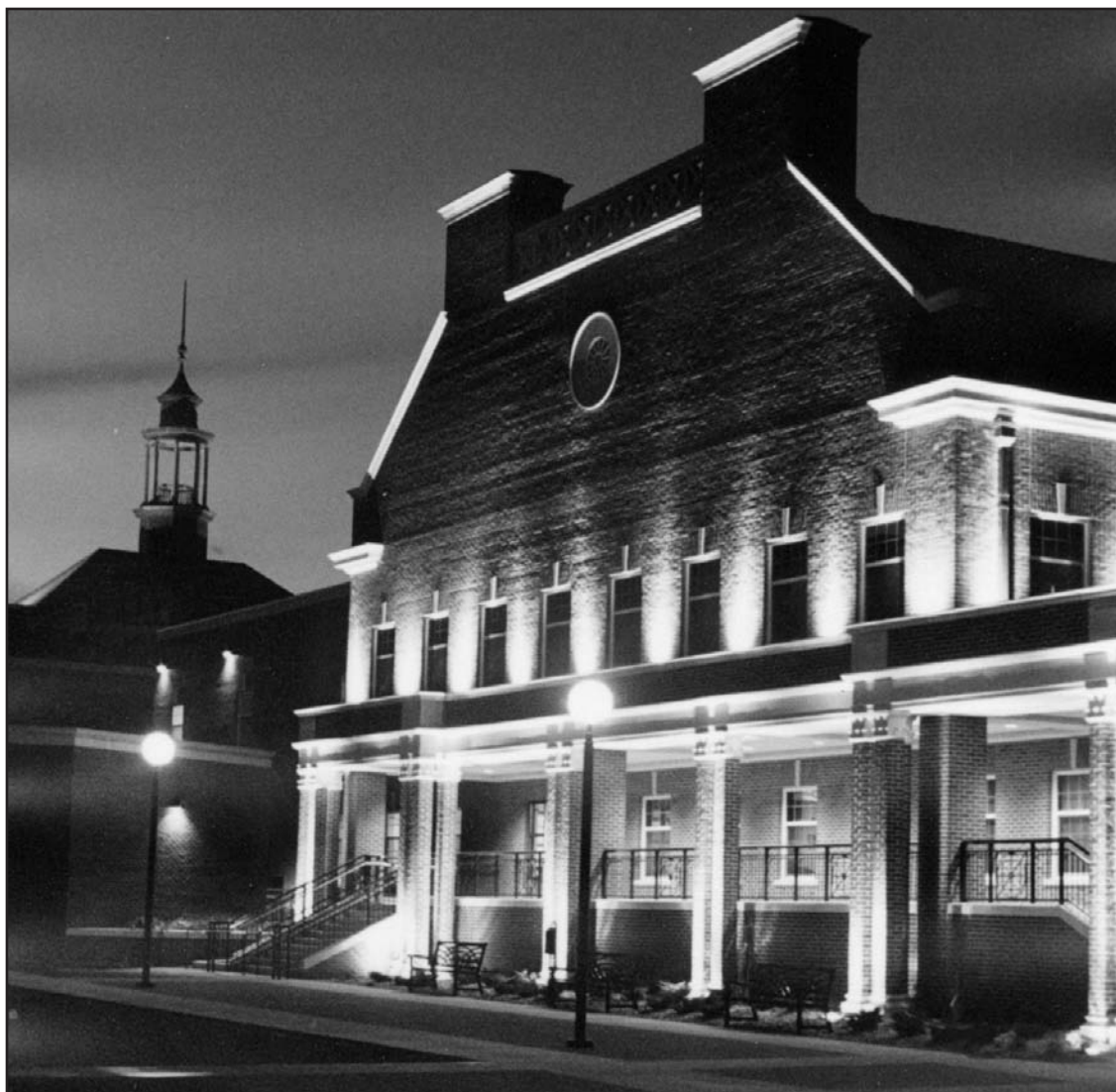
