After an injury-plagued 2005-06, Texas brings back eight letterwinners, including two full-time starters and four others will starting experience.

Forward Tiffany Jackson is the only senior on this year's squad. The two-time All-Big 12 First Team selection has led the squad in scoring the last three seasons and in rebounding the last two. She averaged 14.3 ppg and 8.7 rpg as a junior.

Sophomore Erika Arriaran started all but one game last year and finished second on the team in scoring with 11.5 ppg.

The Longhorns had seven freshmen on last year's roster and lost two of those - Carla Cortijo and Earnesia Williams to season-ending injuries after six games.

Freshman Brittainey Raven is the seventh McDonald's All-American to sign with Texas since the honor started in 2002

Jody Conradt moved to the No. 2 spot in all-time men's or women's collegiate basketball victories last year, surpassing Dean Smith (North Carolina).

Texas A&M returns all five starters from last year's squad that made its first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 1996 and recorded its first 20-win season since '96.


The Aggies' 11 Big 12 wins matched the most ever in conference play and the team finished in the top four of the Big 12 standings for the first time in the 10-year history of the league.

A&M's 23 overall victories marked the third-most in school history.

The team led the Big 12 in scoring defense (57.5), total steals (353) and turnover margin (+7.78).

Junior guard Morenike Atunrase was an All-Big 12 First Team selection last season and led the team with 14.0 ppg.

Kristy Curry begins her first season as the fifth head coach in Lady Raider history. Curry compiled a 179-51 record in seven years at Purdue and was runner-up for the 2001 national championship.

Senior guard Chesley Dabbs returns to Tech after sitting out last year with an injury. She averaged 12.2 ppg and 3.6 rpg in 2004-05.

The Lady Raiders return three starters, led by senior forward Alesha Robertson who averaged 12.5 ppg and 6.7 rpg last season.

Texas Tech needs one more win to reach 100 at the United Spirit Arena, compared to only 11 losses since it opened in 1999.

TTU has finished in the top four nationally in home attendance every year since the inception of the Big 12.

Texas Tech's 118 wins in Big 12 play is a league-best.

TTU led the Big 12 in three-point field goal pct. defense (.270) last year, allowing only 83 made treys for the season.
