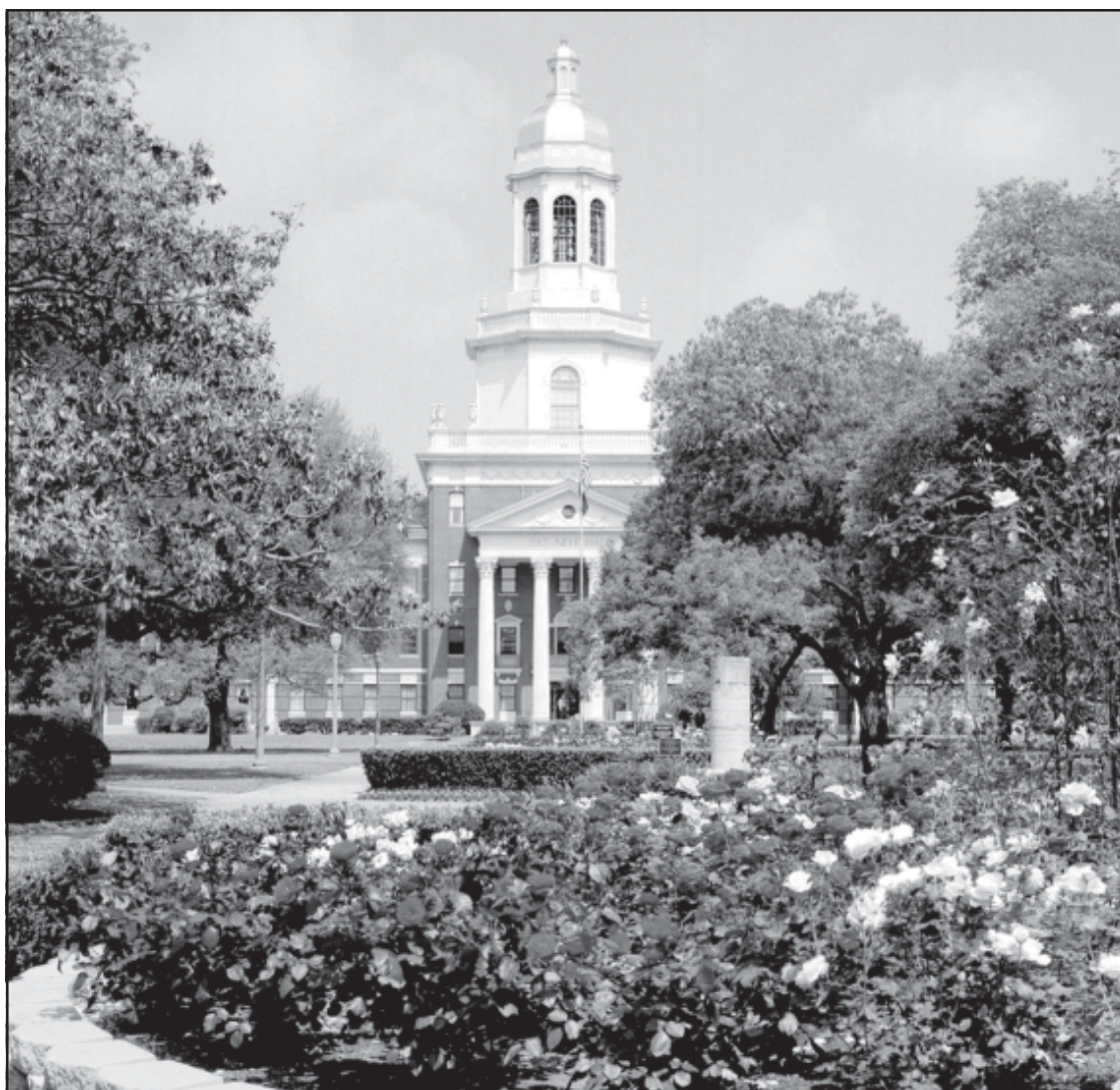

Coaching Achievements: Led Baylor to the Big 12's first basketball national title (men's or women's) in 2005 with a 33-3 mark; Became the first person in women's basketball history to win a national championship as both a player (Louisiana Tech) and head coach, and only the third person to accomplish this feat in both men's and women's basketball; Also won the '05 Big 12 regular season and championship titles en route to her first Big 12 Coach of the Year honor; Turned around the Baylor fortunes in her five years leading the Lady Bears to five postseason appearances, including all four of the school's NCAA Tournament appearances; During her 19-year tenure at Louisiana Tech as both a player and coach was associated with 11 Final Four squads and three national championship teams; Has played or coached in the national championship game on seven occasions; While an assistant coach, helped lead the Lady Techsters to a 430-68 record and seven Final Fours; A member of the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, CoSIDA Academic All-America Hall of Fame, National High School Hall of Fame, Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame, and Louisiana Tech Athletics Hall of Fame.

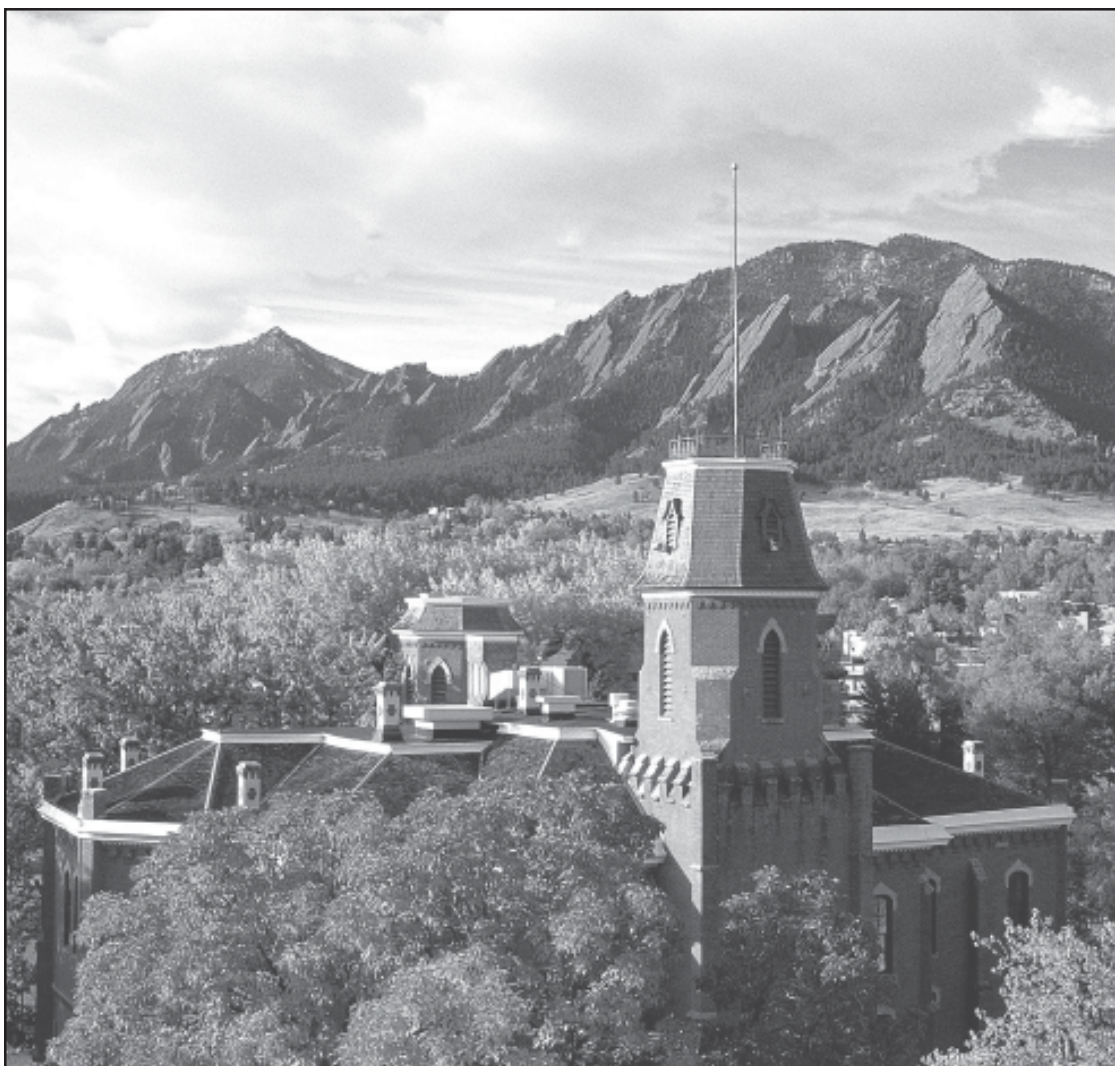

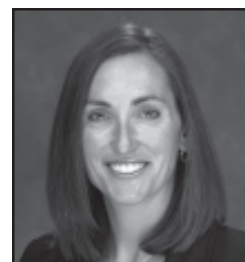

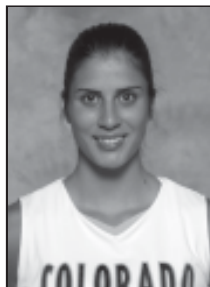
