Forward/Center, 6-2, Senior Topeka, Kan./Topeka

- ★A 2004-05 All-Big 12 honorable mention selection.
- ★Academic All-Big 12.
- ★Became the 18th player in KU history to amass over 1,000 career points, reaching the milestone on Feb. 16, 2005.
- ★The 11th player in Jayhawk history to accumulate 1,000 points and 500 rebounds.
- ★Reached 500 career rebounds on Feb. 9, 2005.
- ★Posted team-highs of 13.8 points and 8.8 boards per game to go with 1.6 assists, 1.5 steals and 0.9 blocks in 33.3 minutes as a sophomore.
- ★Scored in double figures in 20 games last year, including four in which she posted 20 or more points.
- ★Season-high numbers of 27 points against Missouri in Big 12 Championship and 18 rebounds at Ball State.
- ★Recorded 10 double-doubles in 2005 which tied for fourth-most in the Big 12.



ERICA HALLMAN

Guard, 5-8, Senior Covington, Ky./Holmes

- ★A 2004-05 All-Big 12 honorable mention pick.
- ★Averaged 13.1 points, 3.1 rebounds, 5.1 assists and 1.4 steals in 35 minutes of play as a junior.
- ★Started all 28 games at point guard last year, but should be able to move to her natural position of shooting guard in 2005-06.
- ★Has scored in double figures in 35 career games and reached 20+ points on five occasions.
- ★Owns career highs of 22 points vs. Nebraska (2/20/05) and 13 assists vs. Dartmouth (12/18/04).
- ★Ranks in the all-time top five at KU for threepointers made (119, 5th), three-pointers attempted (325, 5th) and three-point field goal percentage (36.6 percent, 5th).
- ★Has 330 career assists, which ranks sixth in Jayhawk career records, seven assists out of fifth place.
- ★Her 142 dimes last year are sixth on the school single season list.
- ★In Big 12 stats last year, ranked 12th in scoring, sixth in assists, ninth in three-point percentage (38.9), sixth in field goals made (61), seventh in assist/turnover ratio (1.71) and fourth in minutes played.
