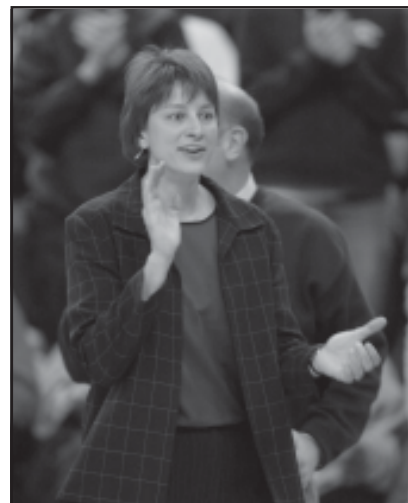

Coaching Achievements: Led Nebraska to consecutive WNIT appearances in her last two seasons; Nebraska achieved one of the nation's top turnarounds in 2004, her second season, finishing 18-12 and advancing to the second round of the WNIT after going 8-20 in 2003; 2002 Missouri Valley Conference Coach of the Year; Led Creighton to the 2002 MVC regular season and tournament titles and a trip to the NCAA Tournament; In her first season at Creighton in 1992-93, led the Bluejays to a 20-8 record, 12-4 conference mark and the school's second-ever trip to the NCAA Tournament; Followed that up in 1993-94 with a 24-7 record and 14-2 MVC mark; Her 2001-02 squad matched the overall record from her second season while setting a school record with 16 conference victories.
