## Game Notes: No. 6 Texas 62, No. 11 Missouri 59

## Individual & Team Notes...

The win for Texas was their 10<sup>th</sup> in a row over Missouri dating back to 2001. Texas is now 17-1 all-time against Missouri.

Kathleen Nash led Texas in scoring with 16 points. She also added 13 rebounds for her fourth double-double of the season.

Earnesia Williams finished with 15 points and 11 rebounds for her first career double-double. It was the first time this season Texas has had multiple players record double-doubles in the same game.

Alyssa Hollins led Missouri in scoring for the 11<sup>th</sup> time this season with 16 points. Hollins also led MU in scoring against Texas during the regular season. The Longhorns won the first meeting in Columbia, Mo., 66-56.

Missouri's Jessra Johnson finished with 11 points and 13 rebounds for her fifth double-double of the season.

## Big 12 Championship Notes...

There were nine ties and six lead changes in the game. Missouri's largest lead was at 10 points and the biggest lead for Texas was eight, both coming in the first half.

Texas is now 2-0 against Missouri at the Big 12 Championship. They are 4-1 as the No. 6 seed and 7-2 in the first round.

The .282 field goal percentage for UT was the second-lowest by a team in the first round. It was also the lowest field goal percentage of the season for Texas.

All-time, the sixth seed is now 8-5 in the first round and the 11<sup>th</sup> seed is 5-8.

Texas' 10-0 game-ending run to secure the come from behind win is a Championship record.
