



2009 Phillips 66 Big 12 Women's Basketball Championship

Game Notes: No. 2 Baylor 67, No. 10 Oklahoma State 62

Individual & Team Notes...

Baylor's Jessica Morrow recorded 11 points by halftime and finished with a team-high 15. She has averaged 11.5 points in her last two games against Oklahoma State this season.

Andrea Riley led the Cowgirls with 17 points and six assists. Riley averaged 17 points against the Lady Bears in their two regular season games. Riley also played all 40 minutes for OSU, the 10th time this season that she has gone the distance.

Oklahoma State's five blocks tied for the most by the Cowgirls this season. Baylor averages 4.8 blocks per game, but recorded no blocks in the contest.

Shaunte' Smith (Oklahoma State) recorded her seventh double-double of the season with 13 points and a team-high 10 rebounds.

Baylor's bench outscored that of OSU, 29-11. Morgan Medlock (14) and Whitney Zachariason (15) accounted for all of Bear's bench points.

Big 12 Championship Notes...

The match-up was only the second time the two teams had met in the Phillips 66 Big 12 Women's Basketball Championship. Baylor defeated OSU in the first-round of the 1997 inaugural event, 68-62.

The Baylor victory gave the Lady Bears a 6-4 record in the quarterfinals. It also marked the fifth time in the last six championships that they have advanced to the semifinals.

Baylor has now competed in 25 games at the Big 12 Women's Championship, which tied for the fourth-most in league history.

OSU's Tegan Cunningham is the first player to foul out of a game at the championship this year. Cunningham picked up her fifth foul with 3:14 remaining in the contest.
