



## 2009 Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship Bricktown Ballpark: May 20, 2009

### Game Notes: No. 8 Baylor 14, No. 1 Texas 9

#### Postgame Notes...

Baylor and Texas met for the sixth time in Big 12 Championship play, with the Bears now owning a 4-2 advantage over the Longhorns.

#### Texas (38-13-1, 0-1 in Pool One)

- Today's game marks Texas' 11th Big 12 Championship appearance, with the Longhorns holding a 23-17 record in championship play.
- Texas is 2-4 in their last six opening games of the Big 12 Championship.
- Baylor's eight runs in the sixth inning is the most given up by the Longhorns' defense this season.
- Brandon Belt's two-run home run in the bottom of the seventh inning marked his seventh homer of the season. He finished the day 4-for-6 with three RBI.
- Kevin Keyes paced the Longhorn offense driving in three runs on a 2-for-5 performance at the plate. This is his fifth multi-RBI game of the season.
- Austin Dicharry was charged with his second loss of the season after surrendering five earned runs on two hits in one-third of an inning of relief.

#### Baylor (28-23, 1-0 in Pool One)

- This is Baylor's 13th Big 12 Championship appearance. The Bears and the Oklahoma Sooners are the only Big 12 teams to have appeared in every conference tournament.
- Baylor entered the tournament as a No. 8 seed for the first time in Big 12 history.
- BU is now 22-20 overall in Big 12 Championship play.
- The Bears extended their record while leading after eight innings to 234-13. This record dates back to the start of the 2002 season.
- Baylor's eight runs in the sixth inning is the most scored in an inning since April 7 against Northwestern State (10 runs in the third).
- Dustin Dickerson has now safely hit in 11 straight games and in 35 of the last 36 games. He finished the day 2-for-5 with three RBI.
- Dan Evatt smashed his seventh home run of the season in the bottom of the eighth inning. He finished the game 2-for-5.
- Kendal Volz recorded his first career save after surrendering two runs on three hits in three innings of relief.
