



2009 Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship

AT&T Bricktown Ballpark: May 21, 2009

Game Notes: No. 4 Kansas State 9, No. 8 Baylor 4

Kansas State (41-15-1, 2-0 Pool One)

- K-State now stands 7-6 in Big 12 Championship play.
- With five stolen bases in the game, the Wildcats have broken the school record for stolen bases in a single season with 143. The previous record was held by the 1985 team which recorded 138 steals.
- A.J. Morris moves into a tie for fifth place in the Big 12 record books for single-season wins (13) after leading his team over Baylor. He finished the day only allowing four runs on nine hits while fanning seven batters in 6.2 innings of work.
- Adam Muenster improved his hitting streak to eight games after going 1-for-4 with one RBI for the night.
- Jason King smashed his fifth triple of the season, marking the most by a Wildcat in a season since Heath Schesser (8) in 1997.
- Dane Yelovich took his 17th pitch for the team this season, setting a single-season school record for most hit-by-pitches.

Baylor (28-14, 1-1 Pool One)

- The Bears are now 22-21 in Big 12 Championship play.
- With the loss Baylor has now been eliminated from the championship game on Sunday, May 24.
- Dustin Dickerson extended his 12-game hitting streak after going 3-for-5 in the loss. He has now safely hit in 36 of the 37 games this season.
- Joey Hainsfurther plated a team-high two runs in the effort.
- Willie Kempf recorded his fifth loss of the season after surrendering five runs, three earned, on seven hits in four innings of work.
