TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Junior guard Brandon Richardson is the top returning scorer for Nebraska after finishing with 8.9 points per game. He more than doubled his scoring average from his freshman campaign.
- Sophomore Jorge Brian Diaz set the Nebraska freshman blocked shots record (41) in 2009-10. He had at least one rejection in six consecutive outings to end the season.
- Nebraska became just the second No. 12 seed in conference history to win its first round game at the Big 12 Championship with a win over No. 5 Missouri. The Huskers have played in the quarterfinals five times.
- Head coach Doc Sadler is the second-winningest in school history through his first four seasons. His total of 70 victories is one behind the school leader (Moe Iba, 71-46) for a four-year span.
- The Huskers held 30 of 33 opponents in 2009-10 to less than 50 percent shooting from the field. NU limited its foes to 65.7 points per game, third in the Big 12.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Senior guard Cade Davis is the lone returning starter for Oklahoma entering this season. He averaged 9.9 points and 3.9 rebounds while grabbing a team-best 46 steals in 2009-10.
- Sophomore forward Andrew Fitzgerald is the top returning shooter for the Sooners, after connecting on 51.1 percent of his field goals in 2009-10. He shot 50 percent or better 13 times.
- OU recorded its first losing season since 1980-81 a year ago. The Sooners have qualified for the postseason in 27 of the last 29 years, including 22 appearances in the NCAA Tournament.
- Head coach Jeff Capel spent the summer directing the USA Basketball U18 Team that won the gold medal with an 81-78 victory over Brazil. It was the first U18 gold medal for the United States.
- Oklahoma welcomes nine new players to its roster after returning just 28 percent of its scoring and 22 percent of its rebounding from 2009-10.

- Senior forward Marshall Moses is the Big 12 active leader in double-figure rebounding games (19) and double-doubles (14) entering the 2010-11 campaign.
- Junior guard Keiton Page is the team's top returning scorer after averaging 10.7 points last season. He has scored in double figures in eight of his last 10 outings.
- Page has made 45 of his last 48 (.938) attempts from the free throw line. He is shooting 82.7 percent from the stripe in his career, a mark that ranks seventh in OSU history.
- Senior forward Matt Pilgrim has shot 50.0 percent or better from the field in 15 of his past 16 contests. He is 15-of-21 (.714) over his last four outings and shot 67.1 percent overall in 2009-10.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Sophomore Jordan Hamilton is the top returning scorer for UT after posting 10.0 points per game in 2009-10. He led the team in 3-pointers (58) and scored in double digits in 18 contests.
- Senior forward Gary Johnson is the most experienced returning player for the Longhorns, having seen action in 88 career games. He ranked second on the team in field goal percentage (.547) and third in rebounding (5.6).
- Texas has earned a bid to the NCAA Tournament in each of the last 12 seasons. The Longhorns are one of six schools to accomplish this feat (Duke, Gonzaga, Kansas, Michigan State, Wisconsin).
- Sophomore guard J'Covan Brown set a Big 12 freshmen record a year ago by connecting on 88.3 percent of free throws. The mark from the line currently places him second on the league career free throw percentage list.
- UT coach Rick Barnes enters his 24th season with a career record of 496-249 (.666). With four victories, he will become the 50th head coach in NCAA history to reach the 500-win plateau and just the 12th active coach to reach the mark.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Texas A&M is one of only two schools in the nation (Pittsburgh) that has won at least one NCAA game each of the past five seasons. The Aggies are 9-12 all-time in NCAA play.
- A&M earned its fifth consecutive NCAA bid last season, one of only 12 teams in the nation to do so. Prior to the current stretch, the Aggies had a total of six NCAA invitations in their history.
- The Aggies have recorded at least 20 wins each of the past six seasons. Prior to the current string, Texas A&M had six years with 20 victories or more in its entire history.
- A&M led the Big 12 in scoring defense in conference games, allowing just 65.8 points per contest. It marked the first time in league history the Aggies have led the Big 12 in the category.
- Texas A&M is one of three schools (KU, UT) that has won at least eight Big 12 games in each of the past six seasons. The Aggies had never reached the .500 mark in league play prior to this stretch.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Texas Tech returns five of its top six scorers from last season and 77.8 percent of its scoring overall. TTU also has 79.8 percent of its rebounds and 78.5 percent of its assists back in 2010-11.
- Senior guard John Roberson is Tech's career leader with 503 assists and ranks 10th on the Big 12 all-time chart. A repeat of the output from his junior year would move him up to third on the Big 12 list.
- The Red Raiders are the most experienced team in the Big 12, with their seven seniors the most of any squad in the conference. With two juniors, Tech has a total of nine upperclassmen.
- Five players on the Texas Tech roster have recorded at least one double-double in their careers. Senior forward Mike Singletary is tied for second among all Big 12 returning players with eight.
- Tech's returning players have combined to play in 505 games in their careers, a total that averages to 56 games for each player who saw action prior to this season.
