Game Notes: No. No. 1 Kansas 80 No. 9 Texas Tech 68

Kansas improves to 25-7 all-time in the Big 12 Championship and 12-2 in quarterfinals contests.

Kansas advances to the semifinals of the Big 12 Championship for the 12th time.

Texas Tech falls to 12-14 all-time in the Big 12 Championship and 4-5 in quarterfinals contests.

With today's victory, **Kansas** becomes the third school in NCAA history to amass 2,000 victories.

Today's match-up was the second between Kansas and Texas Tech in Big 12 Championship history. Kansas defeated Texas Tech 90-50 in the semifinals of the 2002 Big 12 Championship.

Texas Tech is appeared in the quarterfinals of the Big 12 Championship for the 8th time in the last nine years.

Kansas is played in its 33rd Big 12 Championship contest, the most of any Big 12 school.

Kansas guard **Sherron Collins** moved into 5th place on KU's all-time scoring list with 1,822 points, passing Keith Langford (1,812) and Darnell Valentine (1,821).

With six assists, **Sherron Collins** now has 35 career Big 12 Championship assists, ranking him 8th on the all-time list. With three assists in tomorrow's contest, Collins will move into 5th place, passing former Jayhawks Mario Chalmers (36) and Kirk Hinrich (37), along with Oklahoma's Hollis Price (37).

Kansas center **Cole Aldrich** recorded his 14th double-double of the season and 36th of his career.

Cole Aldrich's 18 rebounds matched a season-high (vs. Tennessee).

Cole Aldrich moved into 11th on Kansas' all-time rebounding list with 825, passing Dave Robisch (1969-71). Aldrich is 15 rebounds away from moving into 10th place all-time, passing Clyde Lovellette (1950-52).

Kansas remains a perfect 18-0 when leading at halftime.

Texas Tech senior **John Roberson** moved into 20th place on Texas Tech's all-time scoring list with 1,309 points, passing Koy Smith (1993-96).

John Roberson moved into 10th place on the Big 12 Conference's all-time assist leaders with 491 assists, passing Curtis Jerrells of Baylor (487, 2005-09).

Texas Tech's **Darko Cohadarevic's** 14 points were his second highest point total of the year and his 8th double-digit scoring effort of the season. His seven field goals were a career-high.
