Game Notes: No. 4 Texas A&M 70 No. 12 Nebraska 64

Texas A&M improves to 4-13 all-time in the Big 12 Championship and 3-1 in quarterfinal games.

Nebraska falls to 6-14 all-time in the Big 12 Championship and 2-3 in guarterfinal contests.

Today's quarterfinal match-up between Texas A&M and Nebraska marks the first time the two schools have ever met in the Big 12 Championship.

Texas A&M is now 20-4 when leading at halftime.

Nebraska was just the second 12-seed to advance to a Big 12 Championship quarterfinal. The Huskers appeared in their 5th Big 12 Championship quarterfinal game.

Texas A&M will play No. 1 (nationally-ranked) Kansas in Friday's semifinal. It will be the 6th time in A&M history that the Aggies will play the No. 1 ranked team in the country and third time this season.

Kansas will be **Texas A&M's** 11th nationally-ranked opponent of the season. Going into today's game, the Aggies were tied with Ohio State, Illinois and Georgetown for most games (10) vs. a nationally-ranked opponent this season.

Texas A&M guard **Donald Sloan** tallied 20-plus points for the 11th time this season.

.Texas A&M's Khris Middleton recorded a career-high five steals.

With 17 points, **Khris Middleton** matched his season-high and has scored in double-digits in back-to-back games for the first time in his career.

Texas A&M's Brian Davis matched a season-high with four assists.

Brian Davis failed to reach double-digits in scoring for the first time in five career Big 12 Championship games

Texas A&M junior **Andrew Darko** played a season-high 4 minutes for the Aggies.

Texas A&M is now 22-1 when leading with less than 5:00 minutes left in the second half.

Nebraska guard **Willie Jeter** recorded at least five assists and five rebounds in back-to-back games for the first time this season.

Nebraska's **Sek Henry** played in his 128th career game, moving him into third on Nebraska's all-time list.

Sek Henry matched a season-high with three 3-point field goals.
