

## 2010 Phillips 66 Big 12 Men's Basketball Championship SPRINT CENTER: March 11, 2010

## Game Notes: No. 2 Kansas State 83 No. 7 Oklahoma State 64

**Kansas State** improves to 8-13 all-time in the Big 12 Championship and 3-6 in quarterfinal contests.

**Oklahoma State** falls to 19-12 all-time in the Big 12 Championship and 6-8 in quarterfinal contests.

Today's match-up was the first between Kansas State and Oklahoma State in Big 12 Championship history.

**Kansas State** notches its 25<sup>th</sup> victory of the season, tying the school record for most wins in a season with the 1950-51, 1958-59 and 1987-88 K-State teams.

**Jamar Samuels** established a career-high 27 points. He also established career-highs in free throws made (11) and attempted (14).

Kansas State's **Jamar Samuels** recorded his third double-double of the season and his fourth of his career.

Kansas State's Jacob Pullen has scored in double-digits in all 31 games this season.

Kansas State's 25-point lead matched its largest of the season (vs. South Dakota).

**Kansas State's** 51-point first half was its largest output since 2008 vs. Gardner-Webb (59 points). K-State's 51-point first half was the first 50-point first half in a Big 12 Championship game since 2003 (Texas Tech 50 vs.Texas 32).

Kansas State's **Denis Clemente** notched his first career double-double and tied a career-high 10 assists.

Denis Clemente's 10 assists were most of any Wildcat player in a Big 12 Championship game.

Oklahoma State's 25-point deficit was its largest of the season.

Oklahoma State's **James Anderson** moved past Bryant Reeves for fourth place on OSU's all-time scoring list with 723 points.

**James Anderson** has reached double-figures in points in 46 straight games dating back to last season.

Oklahoma State's **Keiton Page** was 8-14 from three-point field range in OSU's two Big 12 Championship games this week.
