Game 1: No. 9 Kansas State (59) vs. No. 8 Texas Tech (51)

Kansas State Notes

- Big 12 Championship record: 13-13 (overall); 6-3 (first round); 2-2 (vs. TTU)
- Kansas State has now made a 3-point field goal in 106 consecutive games
- Ashley Sweat has scored in 130 consecutive games every game of her K-State career
- Sweat moved into fourth place alone on K-State's single-season free throws made list
- Taelor Karr registered her first career double-double with 16 points and a career-high 12 rebounds
- Three of KSU's last four Big 12 Championship games have been decided by 10 points or less

Texas Tech Notes

- Big 12 Championship record: 13-12 (overall); 2-4 (first round); 2-2 (vs. KSU)
- Now 2-12 when trailing at halftime this year
- This was the fourth game this season TTU failed to make a 3-pointer; three of those games were vs. Big 12 teams
- Senior Jordan Murphree finishes with 1,270 career points, ranking 15th all-time at TTU
- Ashlee Roberson recorded her 11th double-double of the season
- This is the fifth consecutive game TTU had two or fewer players score in double figures

Championship Notes

- No. 8 seed record: 6-8 (first round); 7-14 (overall)
- No. 9 seed record: 8-6 (first round); 8-13 (overall)
- This is the second time a team (TTU) has not made a 3-pointer in a first-round game
- Texas Tech's last Big 12 Championship win was in 2006 (61-42 vs. OSU, first round)
