Game 2: No. 12 Missouri (59) vs. No. 5 Texas (64)

Missouri Notes

- Big 12 Championship record: 6-14 (overall); 5-8 (first round); 0-3 (vs. UT)
- Amanda Hanneman set career highs in 3-pointers (7) and 3-point attempts (13)
- Amanda Hanneman moved up to sixth on MU's career 3-pointers list (113)
- Head coach Cindy Stein closed out her 12-year tenure with a 6-12 Big 12 Championship record
- Amanda Hanneman is the only current MU player to score 20+ points in a Big 12 Championship game

Texas Notes

- Big 12 Championship record: 16-12 (overall); 7-2 (first round); 3-0 (vs. MU)
- Texas is now 5-7 when trailing at the half
- Brittainey Raven was the only Longhorn to score in double figures
- Brittainey Raven logged her 28th double-double of the season
- Every Longhorn who recorded minutes scored at least 2 points (for the 11th time this season); all but two players registered five or more points
- Earnesia Williams reached 1,000 career points (the 35th Longhorn to do so); Texas has three players on its roster with over 1,000 career points (first time since 1991-92, sixth time ever)
- Ashley Gayle's 5 blocks tied for third in first-round Big 12 Championship games

Championship Notes

- No. 5 seed record: 13-1 (first round); 21-13 (overall)
- No. 12 seed record: 1-13 (first round); 1-14 (overall)
- First-session attendance: 3,412
- Missouri's Amanda Hanneman tied the first-round 3-point record (7, Heather Ezell, ISU, March 11, 2008)
- This is the fourth 5/12 seed game decided by less than 10 points (2002, 2005, 2008); and the closest margin since 2005 (No. 5 Iowa State 64, No. 12 Colorado 62)
