Kansas Notes

- Big 12 Championship record: 9-14 (overall); 5-5 (first round); 3-2 (vs. OSU)
- Carolyn Davis' career-high 29 points broke the KU Big 12 Championship single-game scoring record (27, Crystal Kemp vs. MU, 2005)
- Carolyn Davis scored 30+ points for the first time this season; 20+ points for the fourth time
- Carolyn Davis posted her fifth double-double of the season
- For the first time since 2005, KU bowed out of the Big 12 Championship after one game

Oklahoma State Notes

- Big 12 Championship record: 10-13 (overall); 7-6 (first round); 2-3 (vs. KU)
- Andrea Riley registered 20 first-half points, her ninth 20-point half this season
- Andrea Riley's 37 points tied Oklahoma's Courtney Paris for first place on the Big 12 all-time career scoring list with 2,729 points
- Andrea Riley's 37 points was the 11th 30+ point game this season (21st career) and put her over 800 season points (803, second on Big 12 single-season chart)
- Andrea Riley had five assists, just shy of the school career record (695)

- No. 7 seed record: 10-4 (first round); 10-14 (overall)
- No. 10 seed record: 4-10 (first round); 4-14 (overall)
- OSU's Andrea Riley (37) and KU's Carolyn Davis (31) posted the first and third best Big 12 first-round scoring performances, respectively
- Andrea Riley (OSU) set a Big 12 Championship single-game record for field goal attempts (30)
