Game 4: No. 11 Colorado (65) vs. No. 6 Baylor (72)

#### **Colorado Notes**

- Big 12 Championship record: 8-13 (overall); 3-6 (first round); 0-1 (vs. BU)
- Colorado had 39 first-half points, nearly matching its total in a 76-42 loss to Baylor (Feb. 6)
- Alyssa Fressle's three first-half 3-pointers set a career single-game high (finished with three);
  she has scored in double digits in five straight games and eight of the last nine contests
- Alyssa Fressele finished with 16 points, one shy of her season and career best (17)
- Brittany Spears posted her 12th 20+ points game and tied her career best with five steals
- Colorado finished 0-11 against ranked opponents this season and has lost 23 straight to ranked teams

### **Baylor Notes**

- Big 12 Championship record: 17-11 (overall); 5-3 (first round); 1-0 (vs. CU)
- Whitney Zachariason surpassed her career-best with nine first-half points, ending the game with 17
- Baylor improved to 2-5 when trailing at the half
- Morghan Medlock posted her sixth career double-double (fifth this season)

#### **Championship Notes**

- No. 6 seed record: 9-5 (first round); 15-12 (overall)
- No. 11 seed record: 5-9 (first round); 5-14 (overall)
- Second-session attendance: 4,363 (largest second-session crowd since 2007: 5,768)
- Day 1 total attendance: 7,775
- This was the first time Baylor and Colorado faced each other in the Big 12 Championship
- Colorado has lost three-straight first-round Big 12 Championship games
- Baylor advances to the quarterfinals for the 12th time; have made 10 consecutive appearances
