Kansas State Notes

- Big 12 Championship record: 13-14 (overall); 6-4 (quarterfinals); 1-1 (vs. NU)
- Senior Ashley Sweat tied the KSU career records for games played (131, second) and starts (117, fifth)
- Ashley Sweat scored in 131 consecutive games, a school record and the current longest streak in the Big 12
- Brittany Chambers and Taelor Karr finished third (65) and fourth (56), respectively, in the KSU freshman record book for 3-pointers made in a season
- KSU allowed just one 3-pointer (1-of-29) in its two Big 12 Championship games
- KSU committed a season-high 23 turnovers, allowing 20 points

Nebraska Notes

- Big 12 Championship record: 8-13 (overall); 3-5 (quarterfinals); 1-1 (vs. KSU)
- Kelsey Griffin posted 20+ points for the 33rd time in her career; she has scored in double figures 100 times
- Kelsey Griffin recorded her 18th double-double of the season, 38th career
- Cory Montgomery recorded her second double-double of the season, 10th career
- NU's 30-game win streak ties the Big 12 record (Baylor)
- NU's one 3-pointer and 3-point percentage (.048) are season lows

Championship Notes

- No. 1 seed record: 13-1 (quarterfinals); 29-6 (overall)
- No. 9 seed record: 7-7 (quarterfinals); 8-14 (overall)
- This is Nebraska's first Big 12 Championship win since 2006 (four-straight losses)
- Nebraska's 3-point percentage (.048) was the second lowest in a quarterfinal game
