Game 6: No. 5 Texas (64) vs. No. 4 Texas A&M (77)

Texas Notes

- Big 12 Championship record: 16-13 (overall); 6-6 (quarterfinals); 1-2 (vs. TAMU)
- Head coach Gail Goestenkors remains winless against Texas A&M (0-8)
- Ashley Gayle is the first player in UT history to record 100 blocks in a season (102); her total ranks sixth on the Big 12 single-season charts
- Ashley Gayle has recorded a blocked shot in 14 consecutive games
- Ashleigh Fontenette posted her fifth 20+ point game this season; her 21 points are the most she's scored in her five career games against TAMU

Texas A&M Notes

- Big 12 Championship record: 9-12 (overall); 5-1 (quarterfinals); 2-1 (vs. UT)
- Texas A&M advanced to the Big 12 Championship semifinals for the fifth consecutive year
- This is the ninth consecutive game at least three Aggies have scored in double figures
- TAMU beat a conference opponent three times in a season for the third time in school history, and the first time since joining the Big 12 Conference (Baylor in 1993-94 and Houston in 1988-89)
- Tanisha Smith scored 20+ points for the seventh time in her career and the sixth time this season
- Sydney Carter's career-high seven assists give her 100+ in a season for the first time in her career (103)

- No. 4 seed record: 7-6 (quarterfinals); 10-12 (overall)
- No. 5 seed record: 6-6 (quarterfinals); 20-13 (overall)
- Attendance (actual): 5,603
- Texas' season-high 26 turnovers ties the Big 12 quarterfinals record (tied for fourth overall)
- Texas A&M's 14 steals rank fifth (tied) all-time on the Big 12 quarterfinals list
