## Game Notes: No. 2 Kansas State 82 No. 3 Baylor 75

Kansas State advances to its first Big 12 Championship final.

**Kansas State** will appear in its first Conference championship final since 1993 in the Big Eight championship final vs. Missouri.

**Kansas State** and **Kansas** will meet in the Big 12 Conference final for the first time since 1981 in the Big Eight Championship final. Kansas defeated K-State in that game, 80-68.

Kansas State appeared in six Big Eight Conference finals.

**Kansas State** improves to 9-13 all-time in the Big 12 Championship and 1-2 in semifinal contests.

Baylor falls to 9-13 all-time in the Big 12 Championship and 1-2 in semifinal contests.

Baylor appeared in its second consecutive Big 12 Championship semifinal.

Today's match-up was the second between Kansas State and Baylor in Big 12 Championship history. K-State defeated Baylor 74-73 in OT in 2002.

**Kansas State** notches its 26th victory of the season, a new school record.

Kansas State has scored 2,500 points for the third consecutive season.

Kansas State's **Jacob Pullen** has scored in double-digits in all 32 games this season.

Kansas State's **Denis Clemente** has scored in double-figures in 69 career games, including 14 consecutive games.

Kansas State's **Dominique Sutton** recorded his fifth double-double of his career.

**Dominique Sutton's** 14 rebounds were a career-high.

Kansas State's backcourt of **Denis Clemente** and **Jacob Pullen** both scored 20-plus points for the fourth time this season, the first vs. a Big 12 opponent.

Baylor connected on 9 of its first 10 shots from the field.

**Baylor** is now 12-2 on the season when shooting better than 50% from the floor.

Baylor was 57-for-106 from the floor for 53.7% in its two Big 12 Championship games.

Baylor's LaceDarius Dunn has scored 20-plus points 15 times this season.

Baylor's **Ekpe Udoh** recorded his 14<sup>th</sup> double-double of the season.

Baylor's **Josh Lomers** scored in double-digits for the 7<sup>th</sup> time this season.
