Oklahoma State Notes

- Big 12 Championship record: 11-14 (overall); 1-2 (semifinals); 1-2 (vs. OU)
- OSU is 18-2 when leading at the half
- Andrea Riley posted her 13th 30+ game this season (23rd career)
- Andrea Riley posted six complete games in her Big 12 Championship career
- Andrea Riley owns career totals of 2,804 points and 700 assists
- Andrea Riley has posted 11 20+ point halves this year (15 in her career); three in the Big 12 Championship

- Big 12 Championship record: 20-9 (overall); 6-1 (semifinals); 2-1 (vs. OSU)
- Oklahoma advances to the title game for the sixth time (winning four)
- Nyehshia Stevenson moved to second on OU's career 3-pointers made list (154)
- Amanda Thompson posted her 12th double-double of the season (16th career); ranks ninth alltime at OU
