Texas A&M Notes

- Big 12 Championship record: 10-12 (overall); 3-2 (semifinals); 2-1 (vs. NU)
- Texas A&M is the only No. 4 seed to advance to the Big 12 Championship final (three times)
- TAMU is the second team (Iowa State) to make three consecutive appearances in the Big 12 Championship final
- Danielle Adams scored 20+ points for the sixth time this season

Nebraska Notes

- Big 12 Championship record: 8-14 (overall); 0-3 (semifinals); 1-2 (vs. TAMU)
- Nebraska saw its biggest game deficit (-19) of the season against TAMU
- Nebraska remains winless in the Big 12 Championship semifinal round (0-3)
- Nebraska was outrebounded for the seventh time this season
- With four blocks, Catheryn Redmon tied the junior single-season record (60); she's tied for fourth on the all-time season list

Championship Notes

- No. 1 seed record: 9-4 (semifinals); 29-6 (overall)
- No. 4 seed record: 3-5 (semifinals); 10-12 (overall)
- The game's combined score ranks as the third highest point total (150) in a semifinal game
- Texas A&M's 46 rebounds ties the second-most in a Big 12 Championship semifinal game
- Texas A&M's 33 defensive rebounds ranks third in a Big 12 Championship semifinal game
- Texas A&M's 53.1 percent FG shooting ranks fourth in a Big 12 Championship semifinal game
