Game 11: No. 4 Texas A&M (74) vs. No. 3 Oklahoma (67)

Texas A&M Notes

- Big 12 Championship record: 11-12 (overall); 2-1 (final game); 2-2 (vs. OU)
- Texas A&M captured its second Big 12 Championship title, winning both as the No. 4 seed
- Eight 3-pointers is the most TAMU made against a Big 12 foe this season, and the second-most made in a game this season (9 vs. Duke)

Oklahoma Notes

- Big 12 Championship record: 11-15 (overall); 4-2 (final game); 2-2 (vs. TAMU)
- Amanda Thompson posted her 13th double-double of the season (17th career)
- Amanda Thompson scored 20+ points for the third time this season

Championship Notes

- No. 3 seed record: 2-5 (final game); 18-12 (overall)
- No. 4 seed record: 2-1 (final game); 11-12 (overall)
- Attendance (actual): 3,120
- Big 12 Championship total attendance (actual): 25,412; Session average: 4,235
- This is the third time the No. 1 or the No. 2 seed did not play in the Big 12 title game
- Danielle Robinson (OU) joins Andrea Riley (OSU, 2010) and Andria Jones (KSU, 1997) as the only players to log three complete games in one Big 12 Championship
- Amanda Thompson's (OU) 19 rebounds rank third in Big 12 title games
- Amanda Thompson (OU) on the Big 12 Championship career charts: Rebounds (45, third); rebound average (15.0, fourth)
- The overall average winning margin (7.9) is the second closest in Big 12 Championship history (7.8 in 2009)
