Oklahoma State Leads Big 12 Women's Golf Championship

NORMAN, Okla. – Defending champion Oklahoma State fired a five-over par 293 to take a six-stroke lead after the first round of the 2010 Big 12 Women's Golf Championship at the par 72, 6,327-yard Jimmie Austin OU Golf Club.

Texas Tech is in second place with an 11-over 299 while Iowa State is one stroke back of Tech in third with a 300. Colorado and Texas are tied for fourth at 302.

Teammates Victoria Park and Caroline Hedwall (Oklahoma State) both shot two-under par 70 to tie for first among the individual leaders. Park started the day on the back nine where she collected birdies on 12, 13 and 18. She offset three bogeys on the front nine with birdies on holes 1 and 8.

Hedwall played every hole at par or better except for a double bogey on 16. She birdied holes 4, 9, 10 and 13.

Rosalyn Kim (Texas Tech) also finished under-par to placed third with a 71. She collected birdies on 7, 14 and 18 while bogeying 1 and 13. Courtney McKim (Oklahoma State) and Emily Talley (Colorado) are tied for fourth with an even-par 72.

The second round gets underway Saturday at 8 a.m. with Colorado, Texas and Kansas State teeing off the first hole while Texas A&M, Nebraska and Oklahoma swing off 10. The remaining six teams begin at 8:50 a.m. with Oklahoma State, Texas Tech and Oklahoma State on hole 1 and Missouri, Baylor and Kansas starting on hole 10.
