



## **2010 Phillips 66 Big 12 Men's Basketball Championship**

### **SPRINT CENTER: March 13, 2010**

#### Game Notes: No. 1 Kansas 72 No. 2 Kansas State 64

**Kansas** improves to 32-2 on the season and now has its seventh Big 12 Championship title.

**Kansas State** played in its first Big 12 Championship final.

**Kansas State** appeared in its first Conference championship final since 1993 in the Big Eight championship final vs. Missouri.

**Kansas State** and **Kansas** met in the Big 12 Conference final for the first time since 1981 in the Big Eight Championship final. Kansas defeated K-State in that game, 80-68.

**Kansas State** appeared in six Big Eight Conference finals.

**Kansas** improves to 28-7 all-time in the Big 12 Championship.

**Kansas State** falls to 9-14 all-time in the Big 12 Championship.

**Kansas State** is now 5-3 vs. nationally-ranked teams this year.

Kansas State head coach **Frank Martin** coached in his 100<sup>th</sup> career game tonight.

Kansas State's **Jacob Pullen** has scored in double-digits in all 33 games this season.

**Jacob Pullen** is tied for second with Steve Henson (1989-90) for 3-point field goals in a season with 93.

**Jacob Pullen** played in his 100<sup>th</sup> consecutive game tonight, including his 67<sup>th</sup> straight start.

Kansas State's **Denis Clemente** became the 21<sup>st</sup> player in K-State history score 1,000 points and the sixth to do it in two seasons. He is the first two-year player to notch 1,000 points since Mitch Richmond (1,327 points; 1986-88).

Kansas State's **Denis Clemente** has scored in double-figures in 70 career games, including 15 consecutive games.

**Kansas State** established a new school record for points scored in a season with 2,626.

**Kansas State** did not attempt a free throw in the first half.

**Kansas** has now at least 32 wins for the 7<sup>th</sup> time in school history including three of the last four years.

Kansas' **Tyrell Reed** finished with a career-high 15 points and scored in double-digits for the sixth time this season.

Kansas State's **Jamar Samuels** had a career-high in 3-point field goals, finishing with four.

Kansas' **Marcus Morris** led KU in scoring and rebounding for the fifth time this season finishing with 18 points and eight rebounds.

**Kansas** is now 4-0 in the Sprint Center this season and 5-0 in neutral site games.

**Kansas State** now has 1,289 rebounds for the season with ranks ninth all-time in KSU history.
