Oklahoma Sooners

Oklahoma Head Coach Sunny Galloway

On his team's performance: "I thought we played well today. One of the things we talked about before for we started is that one team we know is playing well is A&M. Their RPI is 22, ours is 18 and they had already won today against Texas."

On Bobby Shore's performance after the rough start: "Really good, but let's remember he is really talented. The only trouble he is going to get in is the trouble he gets himself in. I thought he did a great job of settling in."

On Kansas State's chances at getting in the NCAA Tournament: "We talked about it at home plate before the game about it. From what I've seen and from my perspective from the dugout, there is not doubt about it. There is no doubt in my mind that Kansas State is a NCAA tournament team."

Third Baseman Garrett Buchele

On his day at the plate: "I could have gone without the beam balls, but the two bombs felt good. Yeah, I was definitely thinking about three, I was a little bummed about being beamed."

On hosting a regional: "I think we are a team that can go anywhere and play well. For this ball club, it doesn't really matter as much."

Second Baseman Danny Black

On getting rest before the game: "No, we had a lot of time to rest. It was disappointing after last night's game, but we got back to the hotel quick and everyone got to bed. We got to sleep in a little bit and get rested up."

Right Handed Pitcher Bobby Shore

On his rocky start: "Biggest thing is I wasn't throwing strikes, so coach came out there and said you better start throwing strikes."

Kansas State Wildcats

Kansas State Head Coach Brad Hill

Opening Statement: "I think having six runs in the fourth inning was obviously a game changer because we couldn't get anything stopped. We talked about that. That was the one thing we couldn't do against Oklahoma, was give up the big inning. They create a lot of things. They have speed and they have power. They can put you into a little bit of a panic, and they did."

On pitching depth: "We don't feel like we have guys that can go four or five innings, but guys that can come in and get us six outs. We should have guys that can come in and get six outs, three outs or whatever it might be. I thought we had kind of a set up that way but it didn't happen that way."

Third Baseman Adam Muenster

On tonight's game: "It is tough. It's the last time me and (catcher Daniel) Dellasega will ever get to play here. We definitely want to go out with a win, but they just beat us tonight. They swung the bats really well. Like coach said the six runs did kind of deflate us. We never could really get back into the game from there. It is tough to swallow but we have to get rest for this next week."

On getting into a NCAA Regional: "It is going to be awesome. All we can do is wait and find out and hopefully we did enough to get in. If we get there, we are going to try to take advantage of it and win that regional and get a step further than we got last year."

Catcher Daniel Dellasega

On today's game: "We just come out every day and try to play the same so we are still playing for (NCAA) regional berths. I feel like everybody was ready to go, and we just didn't get it done today."

On the positives he has seen from his team during the tournament: "I think today, Ryan Daniel, like coach said, came out and made two or three mistakes and they took advantage of him, but he was pretty sharp other than that. Tyler Sturges came in and did a pretty good job for us. So, I think we can obviously use him down the road too. So, those are two positives that we can take out of it."
