Game Notes: No. 6 Baylor 8 vs. No. 2 Oklahoma 3

Postgame Notes...

With the win, Baylor will advance to play Texas A&M in Sunday's championship game at 1 p.m. on Fox Sports Network. The last time these two teams met in the title game was in 2007 when Texas A&M defeated Baylor, 14-6.

Baylor (33-21, 2-0 in Pool One)

- The Bears are now 25-21 in all-time Big 12 Championship play.
- The appearance in Sunday's championship game will mark the sixth appearance for the Bears, tying Nebraska for the most in the conference. However, they have never taken home the coveted trophy.
- With the win, Baylor pushes its winning streak to seven games, tying their season high dating back to March 6-March 12.
- Pitcher Logan Verrett earned his first save of the season as he threw four innings of shutout ball and only allowed three hits while striking out six Sooners.
- Freshman Cal Towey tied his career-high for RBIs as he led the Bear offense going 2-for-3 at the plate with three RBIs and one run scored.

Oklahoma (43-15, 1-1 in Pool One)

- Oklahoma falls to 23-23 all-time in Big 12 Championship play, and 7-7 under its current format.
- The loss snaps the Sooners eight-game winning streak, and is their first failed comeback attempt in five games.
- Third baseman Garrett Buechele extended his current hitting streak to 7 games after going 2-for-5 at the plate.
- Leftfielder Max White tied his career high with three hits at the plate today. He finished the game 3-for-5 with one run scored.
- Junior pitcher Anthony Collazo made his third appearance in three games for the Sooners. He tossed 1 1/3 innings of shutout ball, allowing only one base runner, while extending his streak to six straight appearances without giving up a run.
