TEAM NOTEBOOK

- OU returns a bulk of its production in every statistical category. The Sooners have six of their top eight scorers back, with 76 percent of the team points and rebounds returning in 2011-12.
- All six of the top eight scorers that return were freshmen or sophomores a year ago. Forward Andrew Fitzgerald led the group with 12.6 points per game, scoring 15 points or more 12 times.
- Sophomore Cameron Clark finished with double-digit point totals in 14 outings in 2010-11. He had one turnover or less in seven of his last eight games and 23 times last season.
- Oklahoma shot 70 percent or better from the free throw line 10 times in its last 12 games a season ago. The Sooners placed third in the Big 12 in overall free throw percentage with a .738 mark.
- Head coach Lon Kruger has won 20 or more games in each of his last five campaigns and 12 times in his career. He has guided his teams to postseason play 17 times, including each of the past five years.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- OSU has won at least 20 games in four of its last five campaigns. The Cowboys have averaged 21.7 wins under head coach Travis Ford, who has personally notched five straight 20-win seasons.
- Oklahoma State has made 15 consecutive postseason appearances (NCAA, NIT) and boasts an all-time winning percentage of .633 in NCAA play. Both marks rank second in the Big 12 behind Kansas.
- Junior guard Keiton Page ranks 10th in the Cowboy record books with 137 career 3-pointers made. He is shooting 36 percent from beyond the arc in his career.
- Page connected on 63-of-68 (.926) free throws in Big 12 play a year ago and shot 89.4 percent overall to lead the Big 12 in both categories. It marked the third time since 2004-05 that a Cowboy has led the Big 12 in conference free throw shooting.
- Oklahoma State has posted a 9-0 record in first round games of the Big 12 Championship, the best first round mark of any team in league history.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Texas earned its 13th consecutive NCAA bid and 29th all-time a year ago. The Longhorns boast a 34-32 (.515) record in their history and are one of four schools nationally to appear in 21 of the last 23 NCAA Championships.
- Junior guard J'Covan Brown was the highest scoring player (10.4 ppg) without a start in the Big 12 a year ago. He has averaged 21.3 points in three career NCAA Tournament contests.
- Brown ranks second on the Big 12 career free throw percentage list with an .870 mark. He has shot 86.1 percent or better from the charity stripe in each of his first two campaigns.
- Coach Rick Barnes is the all-time Big 12 leader in overall (322) and conference game (151) victories. He is the only mentor to have won more than 300 overall contests while at a league school.
- The UT streak of 13 straight NCAA bids is the second-longest in the Big 12 (Kansas, 22). The 'Horns have won 20 or more games in 12 consecutive campaigns and all but one season under Barnes.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Texas A&M earned its school-record sixth straight NCAA Championship berth in 2010-11. Prior to the current streak the Aggies had never played in consecutive NCAA events.
- A&M recorded its seventh consecutive 20-win campaign a year ago. Prior to the current string (which began in 2004-05), the Aggies had just six 20-victory seasons in their entire history.
- Texas A&M is 27-11 in Big 12 regular season play over its last 38 games, the second-best record (Kansas, 34-4) in the league during that span. A&M has won 49 Big 12 contests over the past five seasons.
- The Aggies have won 60 straight non-conference games at Reed Arena. Overall, TAMU is 80-8 (.909) at home since the start of the 2006-07 season and 112-14 (.889) since 2004-05.
- Junior Khris Middleton is one of two returning league players from last year's All-Big 12 Second Team. He led the Aggies in scoring (16 times) and rebounding (14) more than any player on the squad a season ago.

- Junior forward Robert Lewandowski is Texas Tech's top returnee after averaging 8.5 points and 4.8 rebounds last season. He notched 10 double-figure scoring efforts a year ago.
- Sophomore Jaye Crockett saw action in 32 games in 2010-11, the most among returning players. He scored in double digits four times and shot 50 percent or better on 17 occasions.
- Tech has a 7-6 record in the first round of the Big 12 Championship, the third-best win total in the league. The Red Raiders have won at least one game at the event in eight of the last 10 championships.
- Head coach Billy Gillispie returns to the Big 12 for the second time, having previously coached three seasons at Texas A&M. He won 21 or more games overall in each of his three years in the league.
- Gillispie boasts a .729 overall winning percentage and .646 mark in conference games while at Big 12 schools. The marks rank fourth and fifth, respectively, on the all-time league coaching lists.
