



**2011 Phillips 66 Big 12
Women's Basketball Championship
Municipal Auditorium: March 9, 2011**

Game Notes: No. 1 Baylor 86, No. 8 Kansas 51

With the win, Baylor improves to 29-2 and 7-5 in Big 12 Championship quarterfinal contests. BU is now 18-12 in all-time Big 12 Championship games.

With the loss, Kansas dropped to 20-12 this season. KU fell to 3-7 in Big 12 quarterfinal contests, including an 0-4 mark under head coach Bonnie Henrickson. KU is 10-15 in all-time Big 12 Championship contests.

Baylor leads the all-time series with Kansas, 15-7.

Baylor head coach Kim Mulkey improved to 293-78 at BU.

Kansas head coach Bonnie Henrickson fell to 274-169 overall and 116-107 at KU.

Baylor's 35-point margin of victory is tied for second in Big 12 Championship history and ties for the highest margin of victory in quarterfinal history. Iowa State defeated Oklahoma State, 93-58, in the 2000 quarterfinals.

The No. 1 seed in the Big 12 Championship is now 14-1 in quarterfinal contests.

Baylor outrebounded Kansas by 19 today, which ranks as the second largest rebound margin in Big 12 quarterfinal history and tied for fifth in overall Big 12 Championship history.

Brittney Griner hit three free throws against Kansas to move into fourth place on Baylor's career free throw chart with 378.

Baylor broke its single-season school record for 3-pointers. With five treys today, BU has recorded 165 this campaign, eclipsing the 2004-05 squad's mark of 163.

The Lady Bears have not allowed an opponent to shoot 50 percent or better in 168 consecutive contests. Baylor also improved to 24-1 when holding opponents to 60 points or less.

Baylor's eight blocks today are tied for fourth on the Big 12 Championship quarterfinal record list.

Destiny Williams posted a career-high 21 points and two blocked shots for Baylor.

Odyssey Sims tied her career high with six assists for BU.

Monica Engelman moved into 10th place on KU's career 3-point chart with four today for a total of 73.
