

2011 Phillips 66 Big 12 Women's Basketball Championship Municipal Auditorium: March 8, 2011

Game Notes: No. 3 Oklahoma 71, No. 6 Texas Tech 69

For the first time in Big 12 Championship history the higher seeded team has won the first eight games of the tournament and for the sixth time in Big 12 Championship history the top four seeds have advanced to the semifinals.

Attendance for the second session today totaled 4,042 fans. The total attendance for all four sessions of the Big 12 Championship to this point is 16,298.

Oklahoma improved to 21-10 this season and 21-10 in all-time Big 12 Championship contests. OU is now 8-3 in Big 12 Championship quarterfinal games. Oklahoma has advanced to five of the last six Big 12 Championship semifinals.

Texas Tech dropped to 22-10 this season. Tech is now 6-5 in Big 12 Championship quarterfinal contests and 14-13 in all-time Big 12 Championship appearances.

Oklahoma head coach Sherri Coale improved to 334-153 in her career. Texas Tech head coach Kristy Curry dropped to 267-123 in her career and 88-72 at TTU.

The all-time series between Oklahoma and Texas Tech is tied at 22-all. This marked the first meeting between the two teams in a Big 12 Championship.

OU's Danielle Robinson posted 19 points, marking the 113th game of her career and the 29th of the season she has scored in double figures.

OU's Carlee Roethlisberger scored a season-high tying 18 points.

OU's Nicole Griffin posted the first double-double of her career with 10 points and 11 rebounds.

Tech's Monique Smalls matched her career-high of 15 points, which she set yesterday vs. Oklahoma State. It was Smalls' 10th game this season in double figures. Texas Tech's Casey Morris also finished in double figures for the 19th time this season with 13 points.

Christine Hyde passed out a season-high three assists for Texas Tech.

Texas Tech's bench outscored Oklahoma 26-10.
