Postgame Notes...

Oklahoma State will face the winner of Game 2 tomorrow at 4 p.m.
Baylor will face the loser of Game 2 tomorrow at 9 a.m.

Oklahoma State (35-21, 1-0 in Division One)

- The Cowboys are now 13-23 all-time in Big 12 Championship play.
- Junior Hunter Herrera picked up his third win of the season throwing a season-high 95 pitches in 5.2 innings pitched. Herrera did not allow a run while striking out four and walking three.
- Gabe Weidenaar picked up his third save of the season while also picking up his 18th multi-hit game of the season with a 2-3 performance at the plate.
- Third baseman Mark Ginther hit the 27th home run of his career and 10th of the season.
- Catcher Dane Phillips has now reached base safely in 16 consecutive games.
- Oklahoma State has turned a Big 12-leading 71 double plays on the season after turning two against Baylor.

Baylor (29-25, 0-1 in Division One)

- The Bears are now 26-23 all-time in the Big 12 Championship play.
- Baylor is now 2-4 against Oklahoma State in Big 12 Championship play this season.
- Junior Logan Verrett was charged with his sixth loss of the season today after giving up four runs, two earned, on four hits and striking out six batters.
- Verrett walked a career-high five batters, his previous high was four against Missouri on April 11, 2009.
- Designated hitter Joey Hainsfurther picked up his 13th multi-hit game of the season going 2-4 against Oklahoma State.
- First baseman Max Muncy walked three times, moving him into a tie for fourth in the Big 12 with 35 walks on the season.
