Postgame Notes...

Missouri will play Oklahoma State tomorrow at 4 p.m. Texas will play Baylor at 9 a.m.

Missouri (25-30, 1-0 in Division One)

- The Tigers are now 19-21 all-time in Big 12 Championship play.
- Missouri has won the opening-round game to Texas for the second consecutive year.
- The Tigers have won their opening-round game for the fourth consecutive year.
- Sophomore Eric Anderson moved to 3-0 on the season.
- Anderson pitched a career-high 7.0 innings, with his previous high of 5.2 coming against Nebraska in 2010. He also threw a career-high 95 pitches against the Longhorns.
- Left fielder Conner Mach extended his hitting streak to 10 games with a single in the first.

Texas (40-14, 0-1 in Division One)

- The Longhorns are now 26-20 all-time and 1-4 against Missouri in Big 12 Championship Play.
- Texas has dropped the opening-round game to Missouri for the second consecutive year. Missouri, who was also the No. 8 seed, defeated No. 1-seed Texas, 7-3, in the 2010 Big 12 Championship.
- Texas has lost in the opening round for the fourth consecutive year.
- Senior Kendal Carrillo took his first loss of the season throwing 1.1 innings, giving up three runs, all earned.
- Shortstop Brandon Loy extended his hitting streak to 10 games with a single in the fifth inning.
- Third baseman Erich Weiss collected his team-leading ninth multi-RBI game, driving in two against Missouri.
