No. 2 Texas A&M 10, No. 7 Texas Tech 5

Postgame Notes...

Texas A&M will play the winner of Game 4 tomorrow at 7:30 p.m. Texas Tech will play the loser of Game 4 tomorrow at 12:30 p.m.

Texas A&M (39-18, 1-0 in Division Two)

- The Aggies are now 23-19 all-time and 3-4 against the Red Raiders in Big 12 Championship play.
- Texas A&M had 18 hits against the Red Raiders, 5 hits shy of the Big 12 Championship record.
- Texas A&M now has a seven-game winning streak in Big 12 Championship play dating back to the 2009 Big 12 Championship.
- Steve Martin collected the win, giving the senior the first win of his career.
- Jacob House went 5-5 against the Red Raiders, setting a career-high and tying the Big 12 Championship record for hits in a game.
- Matt Juengel hit his fifth home run of the season and 16th of his career with a solo homer in the 6th inning.
- Tyler Naquin's 3-5 performance snapped a 1-17 slump for the right fielder.

Texas Tech (33-24, 0-1 in Division Two)

- The Red Raiders are now 14-23 all-time and 4-3 against the Aggies in Big 12 Championship play.
- Tech is now 5-7 in opening-round play and have not won an opening-round game since defeating the No.1-seed Nebraska in 2005.
- Tech moves to 24-38 on the season against ranked opponents and is also 10-14 against ranked opponents in Big 12 Championship play.
- Nick Popescu became the fifth Texas Tech player to record four hits in a Big 12 Championship game going 4-5 against the Aggies. Popescu also tied the Tech record for hits in a Big 12 Championship game.
- Popescu has reached base safely in 10 consecutive games.
- Kelby Tomlinson collected his 20th multi-hit game of the season going 2-4.
