Postgame Notes...

Kansas State will play Texas A&M tomorrow at 7:30 p.m. Oklahoma will play Texas Tech tomorrow at 12:30 p.m.

Kansas State (35-21, 1-0 in Division Two)

- The Wildcats are now 13-23 all-time and 1-2 against Oklahoma in Big 12 Championship play.
- Kansas State now has a four-game winning streak after sweeping Kansas to secure their spot in the tournament.
- Evan Marshall improved to 5-5 on the season with the win pitching 1.0 inning and throwing 17 pitches.
- James Allen collected his 16th save of the season and 30th of his career, both mark Kansas State records. The junior is now tied for the Big 12 lead in saves this season.
- Designated hitter Ross Kivett led the team, matching his career-high with four hits. Kivett also collected his 12th multi-hit game of the season.
- Third baseman Jason King extended his hitting streak to a career-best 13 games, with a double in the second.

Oklahoma (40-16, 0-1 in Division Two)

- The Sooners are now 24-24 all-time and 2-1 against Kansas State in Big 12 Championship play.
- Kansas State snapped Oklahoma's four-game winning streak in Big 12 Championship opening-round play.
- The Sooners still lead the Big 12 in runs with 407 after their loss to the Wildcats.
- John Jordan was charged with his first loss of the year and is now 4-1 on the season.
- Catcher Tyler Ogle extended his hitting streak to 8 games and has now hit safely in 26 of his last 32 games.
- Shortstop Caleb Bushyhead has hit safely in 24 in his last 34 games.
