Postgame Notes...

Oklahoma will play the loser of Game 8 tomorrow at 7:00 p.m.

Oklahoma (41-16, 1-1 in Division Two)

- The Sooners are now 25-24 all-time and 6-3 against Texas Tech in Big 12 Championship play.
- Cameron Seitzer hit his fourth home run of the season and second in the last 12 games. Seitzer has now reached base safely in 16 straight games.
- Oklahoma has 31 games with double-digit hits this season and a 27-4 mark in those contests.
- Tyler Ogle extended his hitting streak to six games with a single in the second inning.
- Caleb Bushyhead tied a career high with three base hits, marking the 11th time in his career to reach that total.
- Burch Smith had a career high in pitches (146) and innings (8.2) and improved to 10-3 giving Oklahoma a pair of 10-game winners for the first time since 2006.

Texas Tech (33-25, 0-2 in Division Two)

- The Red Raiders are now 14-24 all-time and 3-6 against Oklahoma in Big 12 play.
- Freshman Trey Masek became the first Texas Tech freshman to start a Big 12 Tournament game since Miles Morgan got the start in 2006.
- Masek threw 3.2 innings against the Sooners, snapping a streak of six consecutive starts pitching at least 5.0 innings.
- Junior John Neely now has multiple strikeouts in 18 of his 30 appearances this season after striking out two.
- Senior Nick Popescu has now reached base safely in 11 consecutive games after a single in the eighth inning.
- Popescu also has at least one RBI in nine of his last 10 games, driving in Tech's only run of the game in the eighth inning.
- Sophomore Bo Altobelli extended his hitting streak to 10 games with a single in the eighth inning.
