Postgame Notes...

Texas will play Missouri tomorrow at 9:00 a.m.

Texas (42-14, 2-1 in Division One)

- The Longhorns are now 28-20 all-time and 4-2 against Oklahoma State in Big 12 Championship play.
- Cole Green moved to 7-3 on the season after throwing 6.0 innings and allowing three runs. Green struck out three while walking one.
- Shortstop Brandon Loy extended his hitting streak to 12 games with a double in the first inning.
- With a 3-4 effort at the plate Loy also collected his team-leading 24th multi-hit game of the season.
- Loy also collected his team-leading 14th stolen base.
- Third baseman Erich Weiss leads the Big 12 with 48 walks this season after drawing two walks against Oklahoma State.

Oklahoma State (35-23, 1-2 in Division One)

- The Cowboys are now 13-25 all-time and 2-4 against Texas in Big 12 Championship play.
- Andrew Heaney was charged with the loss and is now 7-4 on the season. He pitched 4.1 innings, allowing six runs, three earned, on seven hits, and struck out three while walking one.
- Oklahoma State turned their 73rd double play of the season, leading the Big 12 Conference. The next highest is Texas Tech with 65.
- Zach Johnson and Louis Uribe are the only Cowboys to have a hit in all three games of 2011 Big 12 Championship.
- Johnson hit his team-leading 13th home run of the season in the sixth inning.
- Junior Devin Shines hit his fourth home run of the season with a two-run shot in the third inning.
