Postgame Notes...

Texas will play Missouri this afternoon at 4 p.m.

Texas (43-14, 2-1 in Division One)

- The Longhorns are now 29-20 all-time and 2-4 against Missouri in Big 12 Championship play.
- Senior Kendal Carrillo is now 5-1 after pitching a season-high 3.2 innings out of the bullpen while allowing one hit.
- Carrillo struck out a season-high six batters while not allowing a walk in the win.
- Carrillo also retired 11 consecutive batters in the outing.
- Short stop Brandon Loy extended his hitting streak to a career-best 13 games with a double in the third inning.
- Loy now ranks fourth in the Big 12 for doubles with 20 after hitting two off the Tigers.
- Loy also tallied his team-leading 23rd multi-hit game of the season after going 3-for-4 with two RBI.

Missouri (26-31, 2-1 in Division One)

- The Tigers are now 20-22 all-time and 4-2 against Texas in Big 12 Championship play.
- The Tigers are now 4-10 this season against opponents ranked in the top 25.
- Senior Jonah Schmidt hit his career-high 26th double of the season in the fourth inning.
- Junior Conner Mach extended his career-long hitting streak to 12 games, going 1-for-4 against the Longhorns.
- Blake Brown now ranks fifth in the Big 12 in walks with 36 this season.
- Matt Stites was charged with the loss and is now 3-6 on the season after throwing 6.2 innings allowing four runs, three earned. Stites walked four while striking out five.
