On the game: "I think the first game really got to be about quality pitching and Kendal stepping up and doing something we haven't asked him to do all year long. He did a brilliant job with extending the innings that he pitched. That part of it was really important. The other part was that on the offensive side we kept grinding it out. We got a run here, a run there. We scored in five different innings, and we had pressure in most of the other innings. We had 11 hits, and a lot of our outs were hit hard. We continue to perform well at the plate. Offensively, we did a good job staying with the inning-to-inning approach. Defensively, we got excellent pitching with quality defense behind it."

On the pitching plan for the second game Saturday: "Hoby Milner will start the second game. We were going to do that no matter what. (Stayton) Thomas hasn't pitched. (Josh) Urban hasn't pitched. (Andrew) McKirahan can come back and pitch. (Corey) Knebel can come back and pitch. It doesn't mean anything other than they're available, but it's going to take the kind of performances we got today out of some guys who haven't had the opportunities up to this point in time."

Kendal Carillo

On his pitching performance after struggling in Wednesday's game against Missouri: "It was huge. The last few outings I kind of got away from what got me here. Today I just went out there and attacked with my fastball. I took it right at them. That's kind of what I've been wanting to do lately. It felt good to get out there and have some success."

On what he had been doing differently in his previous starts: "I was trying to rely on my cutter. It kind of took me away from my aggressiveness and throwing strikes. What I did today was attack them and see if they could beat me with me throwing my fastball."
