Postgame Notes...

Texas A&M will play the winner of Game 13 in the Championship game Sunday at 1 p.m. on FSN.

Texas A&M (40-18, 3-0 in Division Two)

- The Aggies are now 25-19 all-time and 3-0 against Kansas State in Big 12 Championship play.
- With catcher Kevin Gonzalez's walk-off single in the 11th inning, which drove in Matt Juengel, the Aggies clinched their spot in the Big 12 Championship Game.
- This is the first Championship game to go into extra innings since the Aggies captured the 2010 Big 12 Championship with Brodie Greene's walk-off two-run home run in the 10th inning.
- A&M will be making their fifth appearance, and second consecutive, in the Championship game.
- The Aggies move to 5-5 in extra innings this season.
- A&M is now 2-12 when trailing after seven innings. They trailed 7-4 heading into the eighth inning.
- This marks A&M's fourth walk-off win of the season and Gonzalez's first of the season.
- Sophomore Kyle Martin moved to 2-1 on the season after collecting the win against the Wildcats. Martin threw a perfect 3.0 innings out of the bullpen to secure the chance to defend their Big 12 Championship title.

Kansas State (36-23, 2-2 in Division Two)

- The Wildcats are now 9-11 all-time and 0-3 against Texas A&M in Big 12 Championship play.
- Kansas State is now 2-4 in extra innings this season and are 28-3 when leading after seven innings.
- Freshman Ross Kivett snapped his career-long hit streak at 12 games going 0-for-4 including two strikeouts.
- Third baseman Jason King extending his career-long hit streak to 16 games with a single in the fourth inning. King finished the game going 2-for-4.
- Freshman John Fasola was charged with the loss and is now 0-1 on the season after pitching a career-high 2.0 innings allowing one run, which was earned. Fasola walked three and struck out one.
