No. 8 Texas 2, No. 1 Missouri 1

Postgame Notes...

Missouri will face Texas A&M in the Championship game tomorrow at 1 p.m. The game will be televised on FSN.

Missouri (27-31, 3-1 in Division One)

- The Tigers are now 21-22 all-time and 5-2 against Texas in Big 12 Championship play.
- This marks the first time in Big 12 Championship history that a No. 8 seed has advanced to the Championship game.
- This also marks the third appearance in the Championship game for the Tigers. Missouri was defeated by Oklahoma State 10-9 in the 2004 title game and dropped by Texas 12-7 in 2009.
- Left fielder Conner Mach snapped a career-long hitting streak at 12 games going 0-for-4 with one strike out.
- Blake Brown belted his seventh home run of the season and home run of his career.
- Senior Kelly Fick, making his first start of the season, is now 2-2 after collecting the win against the Longhorns. Fick threw a career-high 7.0 innings, scattering four hits while not allowing a run or walk and striking out three.
- Fick threw a career-high 76 pitches while retiring the first nine batters he faced, giving the lefty the longest scoreless outing of his career.
- Senior Phil McCormick tallied his team-leading eighth save of the season throwing 1.2 innings, walking two and striking out four.

Texas (43-15, 3-2 in Division One)

- The Longhorns are now 29-21 all-time and 2-5 against Missouri in Big 12 Championship play.
- Texas is now 27-2 when their opponent scores two or less runs and is 29-3 when the Longhorns outhit their opponent.
- Short stop Brandon Loy extended his hitting streak to a career-long 14 games with a single in the fourth inning.
- Sophomore Hoby Milner was charged with the loss after throwing 7.0 innings allowing three hits and two runs, all earned. Milner walked two and struck out four in the effort.
- Milner gave up his third home run of the season and first since facing Oklahoma on May 1, 2011.
