No. 2 Texas A&M 10, No. 8 Missouri 9 (10 inn.)

Postgame Notes...

Texas A&M (42-18, 4-0 2011 Championship)

- The Aggies are now 26-19 all-time and 3-1 against Missouri in Big 12 Championship play.
- This marks the Aggies' second consecutive and third all-time Big 12 Championship title after defeating Baylor 11-10 in 10 innings with a walk-off, two-run home run.
- The Aggies are now 3-2 in Big 12 Championship title games.
- A&M is now the third team, joining Texas and Nebraska, to win back-to-back Big 12 Championship titles.
- This is the fourth time in Big 12 Championship history that a team has won back-to-back championship with Nebraska winning the 1999, 2000 and 2001 titles and Texas doing it in 2002 and 2003 and then again in 2008 and 2009.
- A&M has now won three of the last five Big 12 Championships (2007, 2010, 2011).
- Today's game marks only the second time a No. 2 seed has captured the championship (Nebraska, 1999).
- This is the fifth time the Big 12 regular season champion has taken the tournament championship.
- All of A&M's victories in the 2011 championship were come from behind wins with two of the wins coming in extra innings.
- Today's game is the fifth title game to go into extra innings in the history of the Big 12 and second consecutive. Texas' back-to-back titles in 2002 and 2003 were also won in extra innings and Oklahoma State defeated Missouri in 13 innings in the 2004 championship.
- A&M now owns a 6-5 record on the season in extra innings games.
- A&M now has a 10-game win streak in Big 12 tournament games with their last loss coming against Missouri in the opening round of the 2009 tournament.
- Second baseman Andrew Collazo hit his first home run of the season to give the Aggies the walk-off victory. Collazo finished the day going 3-for-5, scoring three of the Aggies' runs while taking Most Outstanding Player honors for the 2011 championship.

Missouri (27-32, 3-2 2011 Championship)

- The Tigers are now 21-23 all-time and 1-3 against Texas A&M in Big 12 Championship play.
- Missouri was the first No. 8 seed to play in the Big 12 Championship title game.
- Missouri is now 0-3 in the Big 12 Championship title game.
- Junior Conner Mach hit his fourth homerun of the season in sixth inning in the loss to the Aggies.
- The Tigers are now 11-8 in one-run games this season.
- Missouri lost their first extra-innings game of the season against the Aggies making them now 3-1.
- Senior Jonah Schmidt drove in a season-high four RBI in the loss against Texas A&M.
