COLLEGE FOOTBALL HALL OF FAME

Established in 1947 by the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame, Inc. The first class of enshrinees was inducted in 1951. A nominated player must be out of college at least 10 years and a first-team All-America selection by a major selector during his career. Coaches must be retired three years. The voting is done by a 12-member panel made up of athletics directors, conference and bowl officials, and media representatives.
