TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Baylor is 15-4 all-time in NCAA or NIT play under head coach Scott Drew. The Bears have five 20win seasons in the last six years after posting only three prior to Drew's arrival.
- Senior forward Cory Jefferson led the Bears in scoring in last year's NIT run with 21.6 points per game. He shot 71.9 percent (41-of-57) from the field and has connected at 50 percent or better in 11 of his last 12 contests overall.
- ➢ BU has won at least three games in each of its last four postseason appearances. The Bears have made five postseason appearances in the past six years after posting just seven in the program's first 101 campaigns.
- Senior guard Brady Heslip helped lead Canada to the semifinals of the World University Games this past summer. He shot 43.5 percent from 3-point range in five contests.
- Sophomore center Isaiah Austin had II doubledoubles a year ago, a total that was fourth nationally among freshman.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- lowa State set a Big 12 and school record for 3-point field goals made with 346, breaking the school mark it set two years ago (293). The Cyclones led the nation in 3-pointers in 2012-13, the first Big 12 school to do so in league history.
- Senior Melvin Ejim is the 30th player in school history to post 1,000 career points (1,038). He tied for sixth on ISU's single-season rebound list (326) in 2012-13 and leads all active Big 12 players with 22 career double-doubles.
- Iowa State recorded back-to-back 10-win campaigns in conference play for just the second time in school history (2000-01). The Cyclones are also 32-3 overall at home over the past two years.
- Sophomore forward Georges Niang ranked fifth in the Big 12 in field goal percentage (.515) last season. It was the second straight year an ISU player has been in the top five (Royce White).
- ➤ The Cyclones led the Big 12 in scoring (79.4 ppg) last season, the first time since 2005-06 it had done so. The average also ranked third nationally.

- Head coach Bill Self won his 300th game at Kansas with the victory over North Carolina in the NCAA Tournament. The Jayhawks advanced to the regional semifinals for the 30th time, including six appearances under Self.
- Kansas has won or shared each of the last nine Big 12 regular-season championships. The Jayhawks have earned 13 of the 17 league titles in Big 12 history and have a NCAA-best 56 conference regular-season crowns overall.
- Sophomore forward Perry Ellis averaged 14.3 points at the 2013 Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship en route to all-tournament honors. He had seven double-digit scoring efforts a year ago.
- Junior guard Naadir Tharpe had 113 assists last season, a total that ranks third among returning Big 12 players. He posted seven or more assists in a game four times in 2012-13.
- Under Bill Self, Kansas has won more conference championships (9) than it has lost home games (8), including just two home losses in the last six years. Self is 161-8 in his career at Allen Fieldhouse.

- K-State tied the school record for most conference wins last season, matching the 1958-59 squad that went 14-0 in the first year of the Big Eight.
- The Wildcats became one of two teams in the history of the Big 12 to win the conference championship in football along with the regular season men's basketball and baseball crowns in the same season (Texas, 2005-06).
- Senior Shane Southwell has started in 26 consecutive games for K-State, with the 'Cats posting a 20-6 record in those contests. He is the top returning scorer for Kansas State.
- ➤ Head coach Bruce Weber's 27 wins last year were the most by a first-year coach in the school's 109-year history. He is the fourth head coach at K-State to record at least 20 victories in his first campaign.
- The Wildcats have won at least 21 games each of the past seven seasons. Prior to the current string, K-State had just two 20-win campaigns in the previous 18 years.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Oklahoma posted the 27th 20-win season in school history last year and first since 2008-09. The Sooners surpassed the 80-point mark in five of their last eight games, averaging 77.4 points during the stretch.
- ➤ The Sooners owned four of the top six single-game free throw percentage efforts in the Big 12 last season and led the conference with a .757 mark from the line. It was the first time since 2001-02 that OU has topped the league.
- Oklahoma has competed in the postseason in 28 of the last 32 years. Its 23 NCAA Tournament appearances since 1983 are the second-most among Big 12 schools.
- Senior Cameron Clark has played in all 95 of OU's games during his career. He shot 60.0 percent from the floor over the final 13 outings of 2012-13.
- Coach Lon Kruger surpassed the 500-win plateau for his career last year. He is the only mentor in Division I history to coach five different programs in the NCAA Tournament and the only active one to lead at least four schools to NCAA Tournament wins.
