TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Oklahoma State won 13 conference games for just the third time in school history (1937-38, 2003-04) a year ago. The Cowboys' No. 3 seed in the Big 12 Championship was their highest since winning the postseason title in 2005.
- Sophomore guard Marcus Smart holds the school record for most assists (139) by a freshman, a total that ranks seventh on the all-time Big 12 list. His free throw mark (.777) is also the best by an OSU freshman with at least 75 made.
- Smart had 99 steals last year, a Big 12 single-season freshman record and the second-best total on the overall list. Smart's 58 thefts in conference games only was also a Big 12 record for any player.
- Freshman guard Phil Forte had 68 field goals from 3-point range in 2012-13, a Cowboy single-season freshman record. He also made 73-of-80 (.913) from the free throw line, including an active streak of 27 in a row.
- Oklahoma State brings back its top four scorers and 95.4 percent of its points overall. A total of 82.8 percent of its rebounds will also suit up again in 2013-14.

- ▶ Junior guard Kyan Anderson led the Horned Frogs with 19 double-figure scoring efforts last season. He scored 10 points or more in nine of the last 10 games of the year and is TCU's active career leader in points, assists, steals and 3-pointers.
- Junior forward Amric Fields is expected to return after suffering a knee injury in the third game of 2012-13. He was the Mountain West Sixth Man of the Year during his sophomore campaign after averaging 9.6 points and shooting 51.1 percent.
- TCU held its opponents to 62.6 points per game, ranking third in the Big 12 Conference a year ago. The Frogs limited 20 opponents to 65 points or less and just two foes scored more than 80 points.
- Head coach Trent Johnson has guided his teams to eight postseason appearances, including five NCAA bids. He has won at least 18 games in seven of his last 11 campaigns.
- TCU has made 14 postseason appearances in its history, including seven trips to the NCAA Tournament. The Frogs have also won 11 conference titles.





TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Head coach Tubby Smith arrives at Texas Tech having amassed more than 500 career victories, while recording four Elite Eight appearances and advancing to the Sweet 16 on nine occasions.
- Smith has posted 20 or more victories in a season 19 times, making 17 trips to the NCAA Tournament. In his previous stop at Minnesota, he led the team to five 20-win seasons after inheriting a program that had won just nine games the year prior to his arrival.
- Senior forward Jaye Crockett led the Red Raiders in scoring (11.9 ppg) and rebounding (6.5 rpg) a year ago despite making just four starts. He ranked in the top 16 in the Big 12 in scoring, rebounding and field goal percentage.
- Junior forward Jordan Tolbert averaged 14.6 points in the last five games of 2012-13, scoring in double figures each time. He shot 60.4 percent from the field in the last seven contests of the year.
- Senior forward Dejan Kravic ended the season scoring in double figures in his last three and four of the last five contests. He had four 20-point scoring efforts in 2012-13.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Sophomore guard Eron Harris was just the second Mountaineer freshman to lead the team in singleseason scoring. He scored in double figures in 13 of his last 18 games, including 23 points or more on two occasions.
- Two of the team's top four scorers (Harris, Terry Henderson) were freshmen a year ago with one of them leading the squad in scoring in four of the last five outings. WVU brings back three of its top five scorers this season.
- WVU finished the 2012-13 campaign with a losing record in Big 12 play. It was the first losing record for head coach Bob Huggins in league competition since his first Akron team posted a 6-10 mark in Mid-American Conference play in 1985.
- Huggins has posted a 38-15 mark in conference tournaments during his career, including 10 championships in four different leagues. The Mountaineers are 23-14 in March under Huggins.
- Junior guard Juwan Staten dished out 101 assists last season, his second consecutive year with at least 100 assists.
