TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Baylor is 26-10 in postseason (conference and national) tournaments over the last six seasons, including a 15-5 mark over the past three campaigns. The Bears have advanced to the Sweet 16 three times in the last five years.
- Scott Drew became the winningest coach in school history with the Big 12 Championship semifinal victory over Texas. He has six 20-win seasons in the last seven years, with two Elite Eight appearances and a NIT title.
- Senior guard Kenny Chery led the Big 12 in free throw percentage (.879) a year ago, the second time a BU player has led the league in the category.
- The Bears are 61-4 (.938) when leading at the half since 2011-12. BU has never lost more than two games in a year with a halftime lead during that span.
- Chery finished with 174 assists last season, a total that ranks second among returning Big 12 players. He has posted a 2-to-1 or better assist-to-turnover ratio in 23 of his last 30 games started.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Iowa State won its second postseason Big 12 Championship in school history (2000) and became the first school seeded lower than third to win the title. The Cyclones' 28 overall victories were the second-most in ISU history.
- Fred Hoiberg has 90 wins in his first four seasons as head coach, setting a school record. He has finished fourth or higher in the conference each of the last three years, the first time since 1984-86 that ISU has accomplished that feat.
- Junior forward Georges Niang scored 20 points or more 11 times a year ago. He also recorded 3.6 assists per game, an average that ranked 10th in the Big 12 Conference.
- Sophomore guard Monté Morris set a NCAA season record last season for assist-to-turnover ratio (4.79), including 6.9 in league play. The conference ratio was +2.5 better than the previous Big 12 season mark.
- Junior forward Dustin Hogue had a career-high 34 points on 15-of-19 shooting in the NCAA regional semifinal versus UConn. He averaged 17.7 points and 7.3 boards while shooting 67.2 percent from the field in the 2014 postseason.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Kansas earned the Big 12 regular-season title in 2013-14, the 14th time it has won at least a share of the crown since the league began play (1996-97). KU has 57 conference championships all-time, a NCAA record.
- The Jayhawks' 10 straight league titles ties for the third-best streak in NCAA history. KU has won at least 23 games each year since 1990, including all 11 seasons under head coach Bill Self.
- Sophomore forward Perry Ellis has 82 points (16.4 ppg) in two appearances at the Big 12 Championship. He is shooting 78.6 percent in five career games at the event, which ranks as the best percentage in league history.
- KU leads the Big 12 with 245 regular-season conference victories since 1996-97. The Jayhawks are the only school in the Big 12 to have a winning series record against every conference team.
- Sophomore guard Wayne Selden, Jr. was one of two Jayhawks to start all 35 contests a year ago. He shot 50 percent or better in 16 outings.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Kansas State has posted eight consecutive seasons with at least 20 wins, including an average of 23.5 under head coach Bruce Weber. Prior to the current string, the longest streak of 20-win campaigns was three.
- Freshman guard Marcus Foster had eight 20 point games in 2013-14, including seven in the final 14 outings. He is one of only two true freshmen in K-State history (Michael Beasley) to earn All-Big 12 First, Second or Third Team honors.
- The Wildcats held 15 opponents to their season-low in points a year ago, including 60 or less on 15 occasions. A total of 17 foes were below 40 percent shooting as Kansas State also led the Big 12 in scoring defense (65.4 ppg).
- K-State has made five consecutive NCAA appearances, tying for the ninth-longest active streak in the nation. The school's 28 NCAA bids overall is tied for third in the Big 12.
- The Wildcats bring back their top two scorers from a year ago and six of their top eight. A total of 70.4 percent of K-State's points will return in 2014-15.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Oklahoma's 23 regular season wins last year tied for its fourth-most in the 18-year history of the Big 12. The Sooners averaged 81.9 points (seventh nationally), their highest scoring mark since the 1993-94 campaign (87.4 ppg).
- Junior guard Buddy Hield made 90 shots from 3-point range in 2013-14, the sixth-best single-season total in OU history. His 16.5 points per game was the best by a Sooner since Blake Griffin five years prior.
- Guard Jordan Woodard finished the season with 152 assists, just two shy of the OU freshman record. He dished out multiple assists in 29 of 33 outings in 2013-14, including at least six assists 13 times.
- OU converted at least 10 triples in a school-best 13 outings last year and averaged a school-record 8.64 field goals from 3-point range in 2013-14.
- Junior forward Ryan Spangler was the second Sooner in school history (B. Griffin) to lead the Big 12 in rebounding. Spangler had 15 double-figure rebounding performances on the year.
