TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Oklahoma State has had at least 20 wins in 19 of the last 24 years, including five times in six seasons under coach Travis Ford. Thirteen of OSU's victories in 2013-14 were by 15 points or more.
- Junior guard Phil Forte has had double-figure point totals in nine of his last IO games, including 20 points or more four times. He has shot 40.5 percent from 3-point range during that stretch with I9 assists and just four turnovers.
- Senior Le'Bryan Nash ranks 21st on the OSU career scoring list with 1,307 points after three seasons. He scored in double digits 24 times last season, including 20 points or more on seven occasions.
- In conference play, Forte is shooting 87.6 percent from the free throw line, a mark that ranks fifth on the Big I2 career list. He was perfect from the charity stripe I7 times a year ago.
- The Cowboys averaged 80.2 points last season, a mark that ranked as the fifth-best in school history. Oklahoma State was the only Big I2 team with four players that averaged I3 points or more.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- TCU is eligible to return 84.2 percent of its scoring in 2014-15 and 82.8 percent of its rebounding. Six of the top seven scorers can suit up again and the Horned Frogs will also have four players back that sat out the 2013-14 campaign.
- Senior guard Kyan Anderson scored in double digits in the final I4 games of the 20I3-I4 season, including 20 points or more seven times. He ranks I7th on the TCU career scoring list with I,I83 points and has started 85 consecutive games.
- Sophomore center Karviar Shepherd had a careerhigh 19 points in the season finale versus Baylor, his fourth time in double figures in 2013-14. He had seven games with 10 or more rebounds, secondmost among all Big 12 freshmen.
- Anderson ranked in the top eight in the Big I2 in both scoring (8th, I7.0 ppg) and assists (7th, 4.5) a year ago. He has had at least 90 assists every season of his career.
- Senior forward Amric Fields is expected back after missing part of last season due to injury. He led the team in scoring six times and posted double-figure point totals in I4 of I8 contests.

- ➤ The Longhorns return their entire roster from last season, a squad that made its I5th NCAA appearance under Rick Barnes. UT also welcomes three newcomers, including the No. 2 prospect in the nation by ESPN.com (Myles Turner).



TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Senior guard Robert Turner is the Red Raiders' top returning scorer after posting double figures in I4 outings last year. He started all 32 contests for Tech in 20I3-I4, playing 30 minutes or more I5 times.
- Texas Tech defeated three teams in the USA Today Top 25 last season, the first time it had topped three ranked foes in one year since the 2007-08 campaign. TTU also had four victories versus RPI top 50 opponents.
- The Red Raiders netted I,083 points in the paint in 32 games a season ago, the third-highest total in school history at 33.8 points per game.
- Tech was third in the Big I2 in free throw shooting last year (.728), its highest ranking since 2008-09. The Red Raiders shot 70 percent or better in a school-record II straight games in midseason.
- Junior guard Toddrick Gotcher scored in double figures nine times in 2013-14, including twice in his last three outings. He saw action in all 32 contests and was named Academic All-Big 12 First Team for the second straight campaign.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- West Virginia was one of two Big I2 teams (Texas) with no seniors on its roster a year ago. The Mountaineers will also add two frontcourt players (Jonathan Holton, Elijah Macon) that sat out last season along with five newcomers.
- Senior guard Juwan Staten scored in double figures in 3I games last year, the fourth-best total in school history. He dished out seven or more assists I2 times and finished the year with I97, two short of the school record.
- Staten led the league in both scoring (18.1 ppg) and minutes played (37.3 mpg), the first Mountaineer to lead the Big I2 in an overall individual statistical category since WVU joined the conference.
- The Mountaineers have earned IO postseason bids in the past II years, including seven NCAA appearances. WVU has 25 NCAA bids all-time.
- Sophomore forward Devin Williams posted a double-double in three of his last five outings of 2013-14. He had at least seven rebounds in a game 21 times and his nine double-digit efforts on the boards tied for the most among Big 12 freshmen.


