TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Baylor is coming off back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history. The Bears are 27-12 in postseason (conference and national) tournaments over the past seven seasons, including three Sweet 16 appearances.
- Senior Rico Gathers led the Big I2 last season in rebounds (394), grabbing II.6 per game. The senior ranked third nationally and set the single-season rebound record for Baylor, shattering Charles McKinney's record from 1974.
- The Bears recorded a school-best seven wins over Associated Press top 25 teams during the 2014-15 campaign. The team finished the season ranked No. 16, the second-best final AP ranking in school history.
- Head coach Scott Drew has recorded 20-plus win seasons in seven of the last eight campaigns.
- BU was the only team in the NCAA Tournament to hold every opponent under 75 points in 2014-15. The Bears' 60.2 points per game allowed was their lowest mark since 1958-59 and the first time Baylor has allowed less than 64.0 ppg since 1985-86.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Iowa State advanced to its fourth-straight NCAA Tournament, a school record. The Cyclones are one of two Big I2 schools to qualify each of the last four seasons. ISU finished No. 9 in the AP poll, marking its 37th consecutive week in the top 25.
- Senior forward Georges Niang has 1,510 career points, the I5th Cyclone in school history to reach the 1,500-point plateau. He was the only nonsenior in the nation in 2014-15 with 1,500 points, 450 rebounds and 300 assists in his career.
- Iowa State won its third postseason Big 12 Championship a year ago and first back-to-back conference titles in school history (2000, 2014, 2015). The Cyclones' 25 overall victories tied for third-most in program history.
- The team welcomes four of five starters from last season and returns 71.5 percent of scoring back to the court.
- Junior Monte Morris led the nation in assist-toturnover ratio each of the past two seasons. He finished the 2014-15 campaign averaging II.9 points, 3.4 rebounds and 5.2 assists and led the conference in assists (176).

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Kansas earned the Big 12 regular-season title in 2014-15, the 15th time it has won at least a share of the crown since the league began play (1996-97). KU has 58 conference championships all-time, a NCAA record.
- KU earned its 26th consecutive NCAA bid, the longest streak in the nation and one year away from the all-time tournament record. The Jayhawks have appeared in the NCAA Tournament 44 times, ranking fourth nationally on the all-time list.
- Guard Wayne Selden, Jr. has started every game his first two years in Lawrence. The junior led the team in 3-pointers made (46) and shot 50 percent or better from behind the arc on 12 occasions.
- KU leads the Big I2 with 258 regular-season conference victories since I996-97. The Jayhawks are the only school in the Big I2 to have a winning series record against every league squad.
- Senior Perry Ellis was the only player in the conference to rank in the top IO in scoring, rebounding and field goal percentage. The forward led the team with I3.8 points per game.

- Kansas State held its opponents to 69 points or less in the final seven games of 2014-15. In three years under head coach Bruce Weber, 39 opponents have been held to 60 points or less, with K-State posting a 34-5 mark in those games.
- Junior Wesley Iwundu tallied double figures six times last season. He ranked second on the team in assists and third in rebounds, while shooting 40.4 percent from the field as a sophomore.
- The Wildcats led the Big I2 in rebounding defense during the 20I4-I5 campaign. The team held opponents to a conference-best 30.3 rebounds per game.
- K-State connected from 50 percent or better from the field nine times last season. The team was 8-I when shooting 50 percent or better and 20-5 under head coach Bruce Weber.
- Senior guard Justin Edwards scored in double-figures seven times in 2014-15 and is the Wildcats' top returning scorer (6.3 ppg). He was one of two players on the squad to see action in all 32 games and is also the top returnee in steals with 37.

TEAM NOTEBOOK

- Oklahoma advanced to the regional semifinals for the IOth time in school history and the first time since 2009. The Sooners' 24 overall victories were their most since posting a 30-6 mark during the 2008-09 campaign.
- Senior guard Buddy Hield enters the season with I,366 career points, I5th on the school's all-time scoring list. He converted 93 triples last year, the fourth-most in OU single-season history.
- Forward Ryan Spangler ranks second at OU in career field goal percentage (.582) and eighth in career rebounding average (8.8). The senior has shot 50 percent or better in 55 of his 68 games at OU.
- Oklahoma held opponents to a .386 season field goal mark a year ago, its lowest opponent figure since the 1959-60 season (.339). The percentage ranked No. II in the country.
- OU has won I2 conference games in back-to-back seasons, finishing second in the league in each campaign. The Sooners' 24 victories in Big I2 regular-season play the last two years are their best two-year total since 2008-09.
